### **ANNUAL REPORT: 2022-2023**

### 1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan (RVVP) was established on 10th January, 1987, by the then Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, Government of India, as an autonomous organisation and was registered under the Societies' Registration Act, 1860, vide Regn No. S-17451/1987. Establishment of RVVP was notified in the Gazette of India vide Resolution No. F. 6-3/85-Skt.IV dated 30th March, 1987. It was inaugurated on 10th August, 1987, by the then Minister for Human Resource Development. The main objectives of the Pratishthan are as under:
- (A) Preservation, conservation and development of the oral tradition of Vedic studies.
- (B) Study of the Vedas through Pathashalas as well as other means and institutions.
- (C) Creation and promotion of research facilities so as to bring out the rich wealth of knowledge contained in the Vedas and to relate it to the contemporary needs.
- (D) Collection of information and to arrange basic facilities to store relevant material and to disseminate and publish it in various forms using different resources.
- 1.2. The objectives of the Pratishthan as given in the Memorandum of Association (MoA) are appended at Annexure I.
- 1.3. The office of the Pratishthan was shifted to Ujjain in May, 1993, and it was renamed as "Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan" which was notified in the Gazette of India (Part-1, Section-1) dated 24-12-1993.

#### 2. AUTHORITIES OF PRATISHTHAN

General Body, Governing Council and Finance Committee are the Authorities of the Pratishthan.

2.1 Its Establishment - The rules, regulations, various powers and functions for carrying out the affairs of the Pratishthan are vested in its Authorities. Hon'ble Union Minister for Education, Government of India, is the Chairman of both General Body and Governing Council. The General Body is vested with the general power for reviewing and amending the policies and programmes of the

- Pratishthan. The General Body consists of 31 members. The Governing Council is the principal executive body of the Pratishthan and responsible for the general superintendence, direction and control of its affairs. It consists of nine members.
- 2.2. As per MoA & Rules of the Pratishthan, the Vice Chairman is the Chairman of the Finance Committee which is responsible for all matters regarding the management of the properties and investments, preparation of annual budget and statements of accounts and expenditure of the Pratishthan. The Finance Committee consists of seven members.
- 2.3. Under its general powers, the Pratishthan has constituted Project Committee, Grants-in-Aid Committee, Academic Committee and Examination Committee which comprises of members of eminent scholars of Veda and experts on the subjects for consideration of academic projects and programmes, syllabus and course curriculum and examination matters.
- 2.4. The Government of India reconstituted the General Body and Governing Council vide its order dated 6/4/2021 and Finance Committee vide its order dated 9/8/2021. Orders of constitution of these committees are given in Annexure II to VI.

### 3. OFFICERS OF THE PRATISHTHAN

- 3.1. Under the rules of the Pratishthan, the Hon'ble Minister of Education, Govt. of India, is the ex-officio Chairman of the Pratishthan who presides over the meetings of the General Body and Governing Council.
- 3.2. Under the rules there is also a provision of Vice Chairman to be nominated by the Chairman. The Vice-chairman has to perform such duties and exercise such functions and has such powers as the Chairman may specify generally or in any individual case. Hon'ble Chairman of the Pratishthan has nominated Prof. Prafulla Kumar Mishra, an eminent scholar of Sanskrit, as Vice Chairman of the Pratishthan w.e.f. 20.09.2021 in place of Prof. Devi Prasad Tripathi, the then Vice Chancellor of Uttarakhand Sanskrit University, Haridwar.
- 3.3. There is also a provision of appointment of Secretary, by the Government of India who should be the full time salaried employee of the Pratishthan. He will be the chief Academic and Executive officer as well as Head of administrative activities. The Secretary exercises general supervision and control over the affairs of the Pratishthan and implements all decisions taken by the authorities of the Pratishthan.
- 3.4. Professor Viroopaksha V. Jaddipal has been appointed as full time Secretary of the Pratishthan by the Government of India w.e.f. 07.08.2017. Prof. Virupaksha V. Jaddipal has been re-appointed for five years with effect from 07.08.2022.

### 4. OTHER OFFICERS AND STAFF

- 4.1. The Ministry of Education has approved the revised Recruitment Rules in 2020. The vacant posts are being filled up as per the revised RRs.

### 5. HEADQUARTERS

- 5.1. The Headquarters of the Pratishthan is situated at Veda Vidya Marg, Chintaman Ganesh, Post Jawasiya, Ujjain- 456 006 (M.P.).
- 5.2. For carrying out the activities of the Pratishthan, basic infrastructural facilities have been /are being created in the HQ of the Pratishthan. Govt. of India has been providing funds from time to time for creating these infrastructural facilities. Maintenance of the buildings and other facilities are being looked after by CPWD. Presently, the following facilities are available in the HQ.

Keeping the future requirement of the Pratishthan in view the plan of action has been prepared for further creation of the physical and infrastructural facilities in the campus of the Pratishthan, according to which second stage of the administration building, additional floors in the Pathashala and hostel buildings, museum, library and research centre, guest house and 300 bedded hostel for students have been approved by the Ministry. The works will be executed by the CPWD.

### 6. CORPUS FUND OF PRATISHTHAN

6.1. At the time of establishment of the Pratishthan, Government of India had envisaged that Corpus Fund of Rupees Ten Crores would be placed at its disposal so that income from its investment may be utilized for financing various activities and programmes of the Pratishthan. A sum of Rupees Ten Crores was provided by the Government in instalments by the end of 1996-97 for this purpose.

- 6.2. As per the decision taken by the Finance Committee at its meeting held on 18.10.2001 the Corpus Fund was raised to Rs. 20.51 crore.
- As per the decision taken by the Finance Committee and Governing Council dated 17.10.2016 a sum of Rs. 11.34 crore was added to the Corpus Fund. As on Financial Year 2022-23, the Corpus Fund of the Pratishthan stands at Rs. 31.86 crore.

### 7. FUNDS FOR NEWPROGRAMMES:

- 7.1. The Standing Finance Committee of the Government of India at its meeting held on 24.11.1998 had considered the proposal of the Pratishthan for enhancement of its Corpus Fund. After detailed discussion, the Committee was satisfied about the need and justification for enhanced requirement of funds by the Pratishthan for sustaining the on-going programmes and to introduce new academic programmes which are required to fulfill the objectives of the Pratishthan.
- 7.2. The Standing Finance Committee (SFC) decided to provide the additional requirement of funds by annual budgetary support from the Government. It was also emphasized by SFC that the Pratishthan's activities and programmes would not be allowed to suffer due to paucity of funds and the budgetary allocations would be protected. Pratishthan utilised Rs. 100.58 crores during the year 2022-23 towards release of financial assistance under the scheme and related expenditure, out of which Ministry of Education had sanctioned Rs. 84.05 crores was released by the Ministry as grant-in-aid during 2022-23 and the balance being the unspent amount of the previous year. Out of this amount Rs. 22.08 cr. under capital head is automatically exhausted under TSA system and returned to the Ministry.
- 7.3. Formulation of comprehensive project reports and/or plan of action for implementation of new programmes continued during the year under report.

8.2. The important decisions taken by the Authorities are as follows:

### **Governing Council:** 44<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the GC held on 01-11-2021.

- (2) Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Pratishthan and the Ministry of Education for the year 2022-23 was approved.
- (3) Enhancement of the rates of Honorarium of the teachers in affiliated Veda Pathashalas and GSP Units were approved.
- (4) Minutes of the 63<sup>rd</sup>, 64<sup>th</sup>, 65<sup>th</sup> and 66<sup>th</sup> Finance Committee meetings were approved.
- (5) Minutes of the Grant-in-Aid Committee meetings held on 30-04-2022 and 31-10 -2022 were approved.
- (6) Minutes of the Project Committee meetings held on 25-04-2022 and 27-10-2022 were approved.

- (12) Approved the proposal for alignment of the Vedic courses of the Pratishthan with the National Curriculum for Vocational Education & Training (NCVET) curriculum.
- (13) Chairman of the Governing Council advised the Pratishthan to take appropriate action to teach the Veda students about the ancient Indian knowledge of astrology, vastu shastra, temple rituals etc. along with memorization, recitation and intonation of Vidic shlokas for enhancing the employability of the Vedic students.
- (14) Hon'ble Education Minister and Chairman of the Governing Council directed that various weekly and monthly training programmes may be introduced for teaching Yajnavdiya, temple rituals, vastu shastra etc and submit a proposal through the Ministry for aligning them with the course curriculum of NCVET to improve employability.

- (15) Hon'ble Education Minister and Chairman of the Governing Council advised the Pratishthan to apply for converting the MSRVVP into a Deemed-to-be University. For this purpose, Pratishthan is directed to introduce various sixmonthly Certificate courses, and one-year Diploma courses and two-year Degree courses on Veda Parayan, Vedic Mathematics, Vedic Geometry, Yajna Vidya, Achitecture, Vedic Neuroscience, Veda and Social Science, Ayurveda etc.
- (16) Hon'ble Education Minister emphasized the need for bringing qualitative improvement while enhancing the number of Veda students and teachers.
- (17) Hon'ble Education Minister directed the Pratishthan to take up the special project of assessment of quality in Vedic recitation through artificial intelligence and machine learning immediately.

### Revision of rates of Honorarium of teachers and stipend to students in the financially assisted Veda Pathashalas and GSP Units.

The Governing Council under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Education Minister decided to enhance the rates of honorarium of the teachers and stipend of the Veda students in the financially assisted Veda Pathashalas and GSP Units in its meeting held on 02-01-2023.

Accordingly, the Ministry of Education/ Govt. of India issued approval for the revision of rates vide letter No. 3-7/2021- Skt.I dated 23-03-2023 and the revised rates have been implemented from 01-04-2023 as under:

### C. Stipend for Veda students – @ Rs. 5,000/- per month

Maintenance stipend of Rs. 3,500/- per month per student for food, accommodation, clothing etc. is payable into the account of the Veda Pathashala/GSP Unit and Rs. 1,500/- per month per student is payable into the joint bank account of the students with their parents.

These enhanced rates will be payable out of the grants released by the Ministry of Education/Govt. of India.

- (3) Mark sheets for Veda Bhushan and Veda Vibhushan Examinations have been issued with mention of equivalence to Purva Madhyama and Uttara Madhyama respectively.

# 9. Establishment of Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Sanskrit Shiksha Board and recognition by the Govt. of India as equivalent of 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> std School Board.

Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, Vide Notification F. No. 11-3/2016-Sch 3 dated 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2021 published in the Gazette of India Part I Section 1, empowered the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) to grant equivalence to certificates awarded by various Boards/Universities as equivalent of 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Std Board level examination.

Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, after consultation with the Department of School Education & Literacy, NCERT, CBSE regarding the model bye-laws of the MSRVSS Board, affiliation bye-laws, examination bye-laws and course curriculum, granted recognition to the MSRVSS Board.

The course curriculum of MSRVSS Board has been examined and vetted by the NCERT. The affiliation bye-laws and the examination bye-laws have been examined and vetted by the CBSE.

### **Recognition by the AIU**

The Assiciation of Indian Universities, vide its letter No. AIU/EV/ IN(I)2022/ MSRVSSB dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August, granted recognition to the examinations conducted by MSRVSSB as equivalent of 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Std of State School Board Examinations for admission to higher educational institutions or for employment purposes.

### **Recognition by AICTE**

All India Council for Technical Education, vide its circular No. AICTE/P&AP/Misc /2022 dated 13-09-2022, granted recognition to MSRVSS Board and granted equivalence to the examinations conducted by MSRVSSB to that of 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Std of State School Board Examinations for admission to higher educational institutions or for employment purposes.

### 10. ON-GOING PROGRAMMES AND ACTIVITIES

10.0. Since its inception the Pratishthan has been carrying out activities for achievement of the objectives enunciated in its Memorandum of Association (MoA). During the year under report the following programmes and activities were carried out:-

### 10.1. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO VEDIC INSTITUTIONS FOR PRESERVATION OF ORAL TRADITIONS OF VEDIC STUDIES.

10.1.1. One of the objectives of the Pratishthan as enunciated in its MoA is to establish/ take over/ manage/ provide assistance to Vedic Pathashalas, Vedic Research Centres in the country. Towards achievement of this objective, financial assistance is provided to the Veda Pathashalas and Guru Shishya Parampara (GSP) units throughout the country under the scheme, based on availability of budget and applications received on year to year basis. The scheme of providing financial

- assistance is not a perpetual and guaranteed one. It is a honorarium-based assistance to Veda Pathashalas & GSP Units, provided as per the rules and guidelines of the scheme.
- The Ministry of Education, Government of India, had transferred the scheme of 10.1.2. financial assistance to Veda Pathashalas and GSP Units for promotion of Vedic education to the Pratishthan for implementation along with budgetary support vide its letter No. 8-3/1994 Skt.I dated 19-10-1994. Under this scheme, honorarium to the teachers and stipend to students in Veda Pathashalas/GSP Units are being provided by the Pratishthan from the Grants-in-Aid received from the Ministry under the scheme. From April, 2018 onwards, a fresh Veda Teacher in a Pathashala is given honorarium of Rs. 22,000/- per month. A teacher having teaching experience of more than 5 years and more than 10 years is given honorarium @ Rs. 30,000/- per month and @ Rs. 34,000/- per month respectively. After 31-3-2022, a Veda teacher in Pathashala with 5 years teaching experience and one successful participation in refresher course training will get the 1st enhancement of honorarium and with 10 years teaching experience and successful participation in two refresher course trainings will get the 2<sup>nd</sup> enhancement in honorarium.
- 10.1.3. A Veda student is paid stipend @ Rs. 4000/- p.m., out of which Rs. 3000/- p.m. is towards his maintenance which is paid to the Pathashala Management/ Guru and Rs. 1000/- is towards his scholarship which is deposited in the Joint Bank Account of the student with his parent/guardian. The Management of the Pathashalas and the Gurus are expected to arrange for nutritious standard meal for students, if required, by supplemnting necessary funds from their own resources for the purpose. It is also expected from the Management of Pathashalas/Gurus to keep proper books of accounts of actual expenditure under the head "Maintenance of students" both in respect of grant-in-aid provided by the Pratishthan as well as funds utilized by them from their own resources and produce utilization certificate duly audited by the Auditors.
- 10.1.4. In the year under report 2022-2023, the Ministry of Education, Government of India, released Rs. 84.05 crores as Grant-in-Aid to Pratishthan towards honorarium of teachers and stipend for students in the Veda Pathashalas and GSP Units under the scheme for Preservation of Oral Tradition of Vedic Studies.
- 10.1.5. As per the existing practice, the Pratishthan invited applications from Vedic Pathashalas/Gurus, along with all relevant details regarding teachers and students. Only after scrutiny and satisfactory fulfillment of various conditions and other requirements, financial assistance was provided to various Pathashalas/Units.
- 10.1.6. During the year 2022-2023, Rs. 30,80,00,546/- was released as honorarium to 552 (380 + 73 + 99) teachers and stipend to 3269 students in 112 Veda Pathashalas in Non-NER states.

- 10.1.7. During the year 2022-2023, Rs. 1,94,56,325/- was paid as honorarium to 42 (24 + 6 + 12) teachers and stipend to 200 students in 07 Veda Pathashalas located in the North-Eastern States.
- 10.1.8. A statement of financial assistance provided to Veda Pathashalas / Vidyalayas during 2022-2023, showing quantum of assistance and the purpose for which it was granted, has been furnished at Annexure VII-A & VII-B.
- 10.1.9. During the year 2022-2023, the Veda Gurus who completed five years and ten years of service in Veda Pathshalas/Schools, were given enhancement in honorarium as per rules.

### 10.2. SCHEME FOR PRESERVATION OF ORAL TRADITION OF VEDIC STUDIES

- This scheme has been under operation since the V<sup>th</sup> five year plan and was 10.2.1. transferred by the then Ministry of Human Resource Development to the Pratishthan for implementation since 1.4.1994 vide Ministry's letter No. F. 8-3/94-Skt.I dated 19-10-1994. The objectives of this scheme are to provide special incentive for preservation of the oral tradition of Vedic recitation. Under this scheme, a Swadhyayi teacher is required to teach students at his residence or at any suitable place in his locality. For this purpose the selected Swadhyayi teacher is required to possess proficiency at least in one Shakha of the Vedas and in other subjects as per the syllabus. He is expected to provide special coaching to the students under him to enable the students to acquire proficiency in reciting the complete Samhita with Swara of the particular Shakha in which he is proficient. The duration of the course of Veda study is seven years. After successful completion of study of seven years, certificate of Veda Vibhushan is awarded to the Veda student. The scheme is operated as per the rules of Guru Shishya Parampara (GSP) scheme.
- 10.2.2 During the year under report (2022-23), financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 14,01,15,943/- was provided to 272 Swadhyai teachers and 2073 Veda students in GSP Units in Non-NER states under the Vedic Saswar Yojana.
- 10.2.3. During the year under report (2022-23), financial assistance to the tune of Rs. 1,16,53,000/- was provided to 21 Swadhyai teachers and 187 Veda students in GSP Units in North-Eastern states.

### 10.3. EXAMINATION OF STUDENTS OF VEDA PATHASHALAS/GSP UNITS

10.3.1. Under the scheme of Preservation of Oral Tradition of Vedic Studies the examination of the Veda students in affiliated Veda Pathashalas and GSP Units was conducted in 70 centres for Veda Bhushan and Veda Vibhushan in which 4466 in-house and 1385 external students participated. Similarly, 2056 in-house and 264 external students took part in Veda Bhushan (3<sup>rd</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> year) and Veda Vibhushan (2<sup>nd</sup> year) examinations. For the academic session 2022-23, oral examination of Veda and written examination of modern subjects for the Veda Bhushan students of 1<sup>st</sup> year to 5<sup>th</sup> year and Veda Vibhushan students of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year was

conducted in the Pratishthan-designated centres under the supervision of Centre Supervisors, Vedic Scholars and observers, drafted from Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi and its campus Jagadguru Ramanandacharya Rajasthan Sanskrit Vishwavidyalaya, Jaipur, Guwahati Vishwavidyalaya, Guwahati, Vedic Sansodhan Mandal, Pune, Lucknow University, Lucknow, Sri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University, New Delhi, Gurukul Kangdi Vishwavidyalaya, Haridwar, Allhabad University, Allahabad, Kashi Hindu Vishwavidyalaya, Varanasi, National Sanskrit University, Tirupati, Sri Venkateswar Vedic University, Tirupati, Maharshi Panini Sanskrit Evam Vaidik Vishwavidyalaya, Ujjain, Sri Jagannath Sanskrit University, Puri, etc.

The examinations for Veda Bhushan 3<sup>rd</sup> year, Veda Bhushan 5<sup>th</sup> year and Veda Vibhushan 2<sup>nd</sup> year, conducted by the Pratishthan, have been recognized as equivalent of 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> level Board examination by the AIU and the AICTE.

### 10.4 VEDIC CLASSES FOR ALL INTERESTED PERSONS

- 10.4.1. For spreading Vedic knowledge and awareness, the Pratishthan has a scheme to run Vedic classes for all who have interest in Vedic studies, irrespective of their eligibility or qualification. Under this scheme, lectures are delivered on every Saturday and Sunday, totaling 100 lectures on special topics of Vedas. The structure of syllabus includes various topics decided by the Pratishthan. During the year 2022-2023, the following "Vedic Classes for All"were approved by the Pratishthan.
- 10.4.2. 'Vedic classes for All' was organised at Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan, Bharatpuri, Ujjain (Madhya Pradesh) -

Vedic Classes for All in MSRVVP's Bharatpuri premises was suspended due to Covid-19 pandemic. However, after relaxation in restrictions by the Govt.weekly classes are being conducted from 26-2-2022 onwards.

10.4.3. 'Vedic classes for All' was organized at Shri Shankaracharya Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya, Bharatiya Vidya Bhawan, New Delhi -

'Vedic classes for All' were organized online from 20.08.2022 to 25.02.2023 under the joint auspices of Shri Shankaracharya Sanskrit College, Bharatiya Vidya Bhawan, New Delhi.

In 100 Veda classes, lectures were presented by different scholars on various texts of Vedas, Brahmins, Aranyakas, Upanishads and various religious texts.

10.4.4. 'Vedic classes for All' was organised at Department of Sanskrit, Pali and Prakrit, Bhasha Bhawan, Visva Bharati, Santiniketan, Birbhum (West Bengal)

Vedic classes are being organized online for all from 02.11.2022 under the joint auspices of Department of Sanskrit, Pali and Prakrit, Bhasha Bhawan, Visva Bharati, Shanti Niketan, Birbhum (West Bengal).

In 100 Veda classes, lectures are being delivered by different scholars on various texts of Vedas, Brahmins, Aranyakas, Upanishads and various religious texts.

### 10.4.5. 'Vedic classes for All' was organized at Kendriya Sanskrit Vishwavidyalayarecognised Adarsh Research Institute, Osmania Vishwavidyalaya, Hyderabad (Telangana) -

From 10.12.2022, 'Vedic classes for All' are being organized online under the joint auspices of Kendriya Sanskrit Vishwavidyalaya-recognised Adarsh Research Institute, Osmania Vishwavidyalaya, Hyderabad (Telangana).

In 100 Veda classes, lectures are being delivered by different scholars on various texts of Vedas, Brahmins, Aranyakas, Upanishads and various religious texts.

### 10.4.6. 'Vedic classes for All' was organized at Department of Sanskrit, Tripura University, Survamani Nagar, Agartala (Tripura)

'Vedic classes for All' are being organized online from 03.01.2023 by the Department of Sanskrit, Tripura University, Suryamani Nagar, Agartala (Tripura)

In 100 Veda classes, lectures are being delivered by different scholars on various texts of Vedas, Brahmins, Aranyakas, Upanishads and various religious texts.

#### 10.5. SEMINARS

10.5.1. In order to encourage scholars for research activities inVedic studies, organizing seminars is one of the thrust areas of the Pratishthan. These seminars are either fully or partially financed by the Pratishthan. During the year under report (2022-2023), 8 proposals for All India Veda Seminars were approved out of which only 2 All India Vedic Seminar and 1 National Seminar could be conducted details of which are as under:

# 10.5.2. All India Vedic Seminar organized in Sanskrit Sahitya Parishad, Kolkata.

From 9 to 11 January 2023, All India Vedic Seminar on the topic "Impact of Vedic Culture on Indian Society" was organized in Kolkata under the joint auspices of Sanskrit Sahitya Parishad and Pratishthan.

On the occasion of the inaugural session on 9 January 2023, Swami Atmapriyananda, Prof. Tripti Mukherjee, Prof. Prafulla Kumar Mishra, Prof. Japasidhanand Maharaj, Prof. Ratna Vasu, Sh. P. S. Ghosh, Consultant, MSRVVP and otheres were present.

Various sessions were presided over by Prof. Pradyut Kumar Dutt, Prof. Manjulata Devi, Prof. Didhiti Biswas, Prof. Taraknath Adhikhai Prof. Nabanarayan Bandyopadhyay, Prof. Shanti Pokhrel, Prof. Kishore Chandra Padhi. Thus the three-day seminar was organized successfully.

### 10.5.3. All India Vedic Seminar organized in Department of Sanskrit, Jamia Millia Islamia Central University, New Delhi.

All India Vedic Seminar on the topic "National Unity and World Brotherhood in Vedic Literature" was organized in New Delhi from 10 to 12 February 2023 under the joint aegis of the Department of Sanskrit, Jamia Millia Islamia Central University, New Delhi and the Pratishthan.

On the occasion of the inaugural session on 10 February 2023, Prof. Prafulla Kumar Mishra, Prof. Md. Ishaq, Prof. Rajeshwar Prasad Mishra etc. were present.

Various sessions were presided over by Prof. S.P. Sharma, Prof. Markandeynath Tiwari, Prof. Rambahadur Shukla, Prof. Ramanuj Upadhyay, Dr. Ramachandra, Prof. Deviprasad Tripathi, Prof. Kamalakant Mishra, Prof. Ramraj Upadhyay, Dr. Pushpa Gupta, Prof. Santosh Kumar Shukla, Prof. Omnath Bimbli. Thus the three-day seminar was organized successfully.

# 10.5.4. National Vedic Seminar organized in the Department of Sanskrit, Guwahati University, Guwahati (Assam).

National Vedic Seminar on the topic "North East and Vedas: Traditions and Changes" was organized in Guwahati under the joint aegis of the Department of Sanskrit, Guwahati University, Guwahati (Assam) and the Pratishthan from 10 to 11 March 2023.

On the occasion of the inaugural session on 10 March 2023, Prof. Prahlad R. Joshi, Prof. Manjula Devi, Prof. Hiran Sharma, Prof. NK Pandurang and others. were present.

Scholars from states like West Bengal, Assam, Karnataka etc. participated in the seminar organized from 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> March 2023. Various sessions were presided over by Prof. Rajendra Prasad Sharma, Prof. Deepak Kumar Sharma, Prof. Jagdish Sharma, Dr. Anindya Bandyopadhyay. In this way, the two-day National Vedic Seminar was organized successfully.

#### 10.6. VEDIC CONFERENCE

10.6.1. Vedic conferences have an important place in the programs of the Foundation and are the main means of propagating Vedic study and knowledge throughout the country. All India and regional Vedic conferences are organized every year. These conferences are held over three days with opening and closing ceremonies. These conferences are organized with the cooperation of excellent Vedic institutions, universities, schools etc. as organisers. In places where such institutions are not available, organizing committees of renowned scholars and dignitaries are formed to organize conferences.

In the year under review (2022-23), Pratishthan gave approval to organize 1 All India Vedic Conference and 10 Regional Vedic Conferences out of the

proposals received from various institutions for this project. Out of which 1 All India Vedic Conference and 8 Regional Vedic Conferences were successfully organized, the details of which are as under:-

### 10.6.2. Three-day All India Vedic Conference organized at Maharishi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan, Ujjain (Madhya Pradesh)

Since the All India Veda Conference could not be organized in Delhi, a three-day All India Vedic Conference from 25 to 27 February, 2023 was organized by Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan on the auspicious occasion of Amrit Mahotsav of the country's independence and Vikramotsav Vikram Samvat 2079-80 at Pratishthan Campus, Ujjain.

On this occasion, about 20 eminent guests, 300 Vedic scholars and students from different places of the country participated. As a part of the programme, Yajna was performed in the Pratishthan premises for public welfare and lectures related to Vedas were given by distinguished scholars. Vedic recitation of Sarva Veda Shakha was performed on all three days of conference. Discussion on examination and skill development and cultural programs were organised by Vedic students. Veda Sandesh/Ved Jagran Yatra was taken out through the main roads of the city for three days. The book "Laghu Mantra Sampat" published by the Pratishthan was released by the esteemed guests. In this way, the three-day All India Veda Conference was successfully organized.

On the occasion of Vikramotsav 2023 (Vikram Samvat 2079-80), All India Veda Conference-2022-23 was organized in Ujjain. Vedic conferences have an important place in the programs of the Pratishthan and are the main means of propagating Veda awareness and Vedic knowledge throughout the country. These conferences are organized with the cooperation of eminent Vedic institutions, universities, schools etc. as organisers. Keeping in view the promotion and dissemination of Vedic knowledge in the entire country, Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan, Ujjain organizes six regional Ved Sammelans, one regional Ved Sammelan in the north-eastern state and one All India Ved Sammelan every year. Young and wellknown Veda pathees and eminent Vedic scholars of the country take part in these programmes.

Ujjain is the city of Lord Mahakal and justice King Vikramaditya. Keeping this in mind, the Madhya Pradesh government decided to celebrate Vikram Utsav from Shivratri to Gudi Padwa. On this occasion, the responsibility of organizing the All India Veda Conference in Ujjain was given to the Pratishthan.

Hon'ble Education Minister, Government of India, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan Ji has directed that every year Veda Praryan of all the branches of Vedas should be performed before Lord Mahakal and the Vedpathis associated with the Pratishthan should be invited to Ujjain once a year to perform Veda Parayan themselves and take part in Veda Sandesh Yatra to create awareness about Vedas in the society, prepare programs for the entire year and bring innovative ways for promotion and

propagation of Vedic knowledge. Keeping these instructions in mind, All India Veda Conference was organized in the Pratishthan premises from 25 to 27 February, 2023.

**Veda Sandesh Yatra on the occasion of Vikramotsav 2023 (Vikram Samvat 2079-80) -** On the eve of All India Veda Conference, on 24-2-2023, a grand Ved Sandesh Yatra (Vedic procession) was taken out with tableaux through the main rods in the city of Ujjain from the Tower Chowk to Dussehra ground with chanting of Veda mantras. The dignitaries of the city, Vedapathis present in the evening, Veda students of the city and thousands of people from the society took part in the procession.

**Veda Sandesh Yatra to Chintaman Ganesh Temple** – On the morning of 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2023, before the inaugural session of the All India Veda Conference Veda Sandesh Yatra was taken out from the Pratishthan premises to Chintaman Ganesh Temple with recitation of Veda mantras. Veda Sandesh Yatra (Vedic procession) was taken out to seek blessings from Lord Shri Chitanman Ganesh Ji. Eminent guests from different parts of the country, Vedic scholars, students and officers and employees of the establishment participated in the procession.

Inauguration and the auspicious beginning- The All India three-day Veda Conference was inaugurated on 25-2-2023 at 11.00 a.m. with Vedic Mangalacharan and lighting of the lamp in front of the statue of Goddess Saraswati by the special guests. The students of Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya presented a welcome song in Sanskrit to welcome the guests. Chief Guest Dr. Mohan Yaday, Hon'ble Education Minister, Government of Madhya Pradesh, Emionent Guest Prof. Murali Manohar Pathak, New Delhi, Prof. Prafulla Kumar Mishra, Vice Chairman of the Pratishthan, Mahant Sri Vineetgiriji Maharaj, Mahant Gadi, Sri Mahakal Mandir, Ujjain, Prof. K.E. Devanathan, former Vice Chancellor, Sri Venkateswara Vedic University, Tirupati, Prof. Devi Prasad Tripathi, former Vice Chancellor, Uttarakhand Sanskrit University, Haridwar was present on the stage. Secretary of the Pratishthan Prof. Viroopaksha V. Jaddipal honoured the guests with shawl and coconut. The book "Laghu Mantra Sampat" published by the Pratishthan was released by the guests. Mahant Shri Vineetgiriji Maharaj, Mahant Gadi, Sri Mahakal Mandir, Ujjain has been the source of inspiration for the short book.

Expressing the sentiments of Hon'ble Shri Dharmendra Pradhan Ji, the Hon'ble Education Minister of the Government of India and Chairman of the Pratishthan, Dr. Mohan Yadav, Hon'able Minister of Higher Education, Government of Madhya Pradesh said in his address that this Veda Vidya Pratishthan will soon be converted into a Central Vedic University. He said that all necessary support will be provided for the development of the Pratishthan.

In the inaugural session of the Veda Sammelan, the Secretary of the Pratishthan, Prof. Viroopaksha V. Jaddipal said that this Veda Sammelan is being organized with the aim of spreading the knowledge of Vedas among the people and taking the people towards spiritual prosperity with their sattvik energy. Veda is not just a religious book, it is the basic source of human values of entire humanity, which has been accepted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its judgment. On this occasion the book "Laghu Mantra Sampat" was released. This book has been prepared with a view to disseminate Vedic knowledge and science to the general public and to use the knowledge contained in the Vedas in daily activities.

Dr. Amaldhari Singh from Kashi, presented all four copies of the Shankhayan branch of Rigveda to the Hon'ble Minister. Mahant Shri Vineetgiriji Maharaj, Mahant Gadi, Sri Mahakal Mandir, Ujjain said that the way western culture is becoming dominant in our country, there is a need to save our society, to save the culture and existence of India, to secure our nation and religion. From this point of view, Vedas are the only way to uplift our spiritual consciousness and there is a need for such conferences and deliberative sessions. Materialism attains validity when practiced with Vedic knowledge. If there is no light of Vedic knowledge in materialism then it becomes a curse. Former Vice Chairman of the Pratishthan and former Vice Chancellor of Uttarakhand Sanskrit University, Prof. Deviprasad Tripathi who graced the occasion with his presence said that Vedas are the only means to develop peace, prosperity and harmony in the entire world, whose propagation is needed for the entire humanity. Vice Chancellor of Sri Lal Bahadur Shastri Central University, Prof. Murli Manohar Pathak Ji said that we are continuously making efforts for the development of Vedic students and we are always ready to make any arrangement. Former Vice Chancellor of Sri Venkateswara Vedic University, Tirupati, Prof. K.E. Devanathan Ji deliberated on some valuable topics on Vedas and scriptures.

Hon'ble Vice President of the Pratishthan Prof. Prafulla Kumar Mishra said in his presidential address that even though there is no Vedic tradition in western universities, the students there have deep faith in the Vedas. Everyone's attention is on our traditional Veda studies and research on Vedas is being done in the universities of the world. The program was compered by Dr. Anup Kumar Mishra, Section Officer and vote of thanks was given by Shri Sanjay Srivastava, Assistant Director.

Veda Shakha Swadhyaya and Shakha Parayan (First Day) - On 25.02.2023 at 2.30 pm, Veda Swadhyaya/Parayan of each branch was performed in the pandal which was organized by the Veda teachers of Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya. Pt. Vinayak Moroshwar Ghaisas Guruji from Pune, Pt. Uday Vaidya, from Swarnvalli, Pt.. Satyam Shukla and Pt. Chidanand Shastri, from RAVV- Ujjain, Pt. Vikash Pandey from Ghaziabad, Pt. At 8.00 pm, the students of Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya presented a short play named Tattvamasi which was composed and directed by Shri Shivankar Pathak Ji.

Veda Sandesh Yatra on 26.02.2023 - On the morning of 26.02.2023, a grand procession was taken out with tableaux from Mahakal temple area to Kshir Sagar

with chanting of Veda mantras in Ujjain city. Several dignitaries of the city, Vedapathis and more than 300 Veda students and thousands of people from the society participated.

Veda Shakha Swadhyaya and Parayan (Second Day) - On 26.2.2023, Veda Swadhyaya and parayan of each shakha was organized in the pandal from 10.00 am to 12.30 am and from 2.30 to 5.00 pm, which was coordinated by the Veda teachers of the Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya. The Vedapathees present in the sammelan recited the Vedas with guidance from the seniors.

Discussion on examination and skill development - Prof. Murli Manohar Pathak, Vice Chancellor, Sri Lal Bahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit University, New Delhi, Prof. Girish Pant Ji, Governing Council member, Prof. Ganesh Bhardwaj Ji, Project Committee member, Prof. Muralikrishna Ji, Professor (Member nominated by the Vice Chancellor of Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi), New Delhi Prof. Madhukeshwar Bhatt (Member nominated by the Vice Chancellor of Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi), and Prof. Kishore Chandra Padhi, former Vice Chancellor, Shri Jagannath Sanskrit University, discussed the issue of conducting examinations of Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedvidya Pratishthan, Ujjain and Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Sanskrit Shiksha Board and suggestions were offered for maintaining the quality. From 07 to 09 October 2022, the Regional Veda Conference was organized in Kankhal, Haridwar under the joint auspices of Vedasthali Ved Pathshala, Shri Maheshwaranand Sangveda Mahavidyalaya, Kankhal, Haridwar and the Pratishthan.

On this occasion, Smt. Ritu Khanduri, Hon'ble Dr. Dhansingh Rawat, Shri Madan Kaushik, Acharya Shri Balkrishna, Prof. Devi Prasad Tripathi, Prof. Viroopaksha V. Jaddipal and others were present. In this way the three-day Regional Vedic Conference was successfully completed.

### 10.6.4. Three-day Regional Vedic Conference organized at Shri Ram Ved Vidyalaya, Karsevak Puram, Ayodhya (Uttar Pradesh)

From 13 to 15 March 2023, the Regional Vedic Conference was organized in Vadodara under the joint auspices of Shri Maharudra Hanuman Seva Sansthan, Vadodara and the Pratishthan.

On this occasion Sh. Shridhar Adi, Sh. Kunjbihari Upadhyay, Sh. Rajendra Purushottam Dani, Sh. Harikesh Kulkarni and others were present. In this way the organization of the three-day Regional Vedic Conference was successfully completed.

10.7.1. Pratishthan had started a program of celebrating Veda Gyan Saptah (Veda Awareness Week) in different parts of the country to create awareness about Vedic knowledge and the human values inherent in it. The objective of this program is to create awareness about the Vedas, Vedic knowledge and Indian culture in the country. Under this programme, activities like lectures by eminent Vedic scholars on selected topics of utility to the general public, exhibitions through pictures, charts and models etc. is organized during a whole week as per the accepted rules and procedures by reputed Vedic institutions or scholars. Grants are given for organizing events, delivering speeches by eminent Vedic scholars, broadcasting appropriate messages related to Vedic hymns on the network of All India Radio and Doordarshan, organizing competitions among students in reciting Vedic hymns/mantras and awarding them prizes and honoring scholars.

During the year under report (2022-23), two Ved Gyan Saptah (Veda Awareness Week) celebrations were successfully organized, the details of which are as under:-

### 10.7.2. Veda Gyan Saptah organized by Dev Sanskriti Devvani Mandir, Hooghly, (West Bengal)

Veda Gyan Saptah (Veda Awarenessa Week) was organized in Hooghly, West Bengal, under the joint auspices of Dev Sanskriti Devvani Mandir, Hooghly and the Pratishthan from 05 to 11 October 2022.

## 10.7.3. Veda Gyan Week organized by Social Organization for Voluntary Action, Ronpur, Nayagarh (Odisha)

From 14 to 20 December 2022, Veda Gyan Saptah (Veda Awareness Week) was organized in Ronpur, Nayagarh under the joint auspices of Social Organization for Voluntary Action, Ronpur, Nayagarh and the Pratishthan.

#### 10.8. PUBLICATION

10.8.1. Publication is an important programme of the Pratisthan to fulfill its objectives. The out of print and rare texts relating to Vedic literature are reprinted and published under this programme. Printing of critical editions and translation into various languages of certain texts, monographs on important topics and report of research work done by fellows of the Pratishthan are also undertaken. In addition the research papers presented at the seminars, workshops and proceedings of these are also taken up for publication.

### 10.9. PUBLICATION OF RESEARCH JOURNAL

10.9.1. In order to promote new research activities Pratisthan publishes an International Research Journal "Ved Vidya" in which good selected essays related to Veda are published in Hindi, English and Sanskrit languages so that its advantage may be availed of by the Vedic scholars as well as by general public. This research journal contains ISSN No. 2230-8962 and is a recognized refereed research journal included in the CARE list of UGC at Sl. No.97 of the Chapter of Indian

Languages. The research papers published in Ved Vidya are recognized by the Universities in connection with various academic matters. Ved Vidya Issue from 1 to 28 have been published in book form and from Issue no.29 to 36 have been published online. Process for publication in book form is under way.

10.9.2. The details of texts published so far and financial assistance provided for publication are furnished in the Annexure -IX.

#### 10.10. LIBRARY

10.10.1. The Pratishthan has its own well maintained library at Ujjain. At present it has got about 9000 books on its shelves on Vedic literature and related subjects. The collection is in the process of being computerized. Books needed for Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya being run by the Pratishthan and for research purposes are available in the library.

#### 10.11. PREPARATION OF VEDIC DIRECTORY

10.11.1. In order to preserve and conserve the oral tradition of Vedic recitation, a directory of Vedic scholars of different branches is being prepared. In fact this Vedic Directory has been demanded by Vedic Scholars since long and is now under implementation.

#### 10.12. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO AGED VEDAPATHIS

- 10.12.1. Traditional Vedapathis and Vedic scholars who are above 65 years of age and are devoted to Veda learning/teaching in any one of the Veda shakhas with distinction are provided with financial assistance of Rs. 4000/- per month.
- 10.12.2. Pratishthan provides financial assistance to aged handicapped Vedapathis above 65 years of age. During the year under report (2022-23), 20 aged and handicapped Vedpathis were provided financial assistance of Rs 9,32,000/-at the rate of Rs. 4000/- each per month.
- 10.12.3. During the year under report (2022-23) grant of Rs. 5.50 lakhs has been provided to Vedpata Nidhi Trust, Chennai, as Pratishthan's contribution under the scheme of assisting the aged Vedic Pandits.

### 10.13. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO NITYAGNIHOTRIS

- 10.13.1. The Pratishthan has a scheme to provide financial assistance of Rs. 4000 per month to each of those Nityagnihotris who along with their wives perform and follow traditional Vedic recitations with Agnihotra Anushthan as per procedure and cow worship at their homes regularly. The objective of providing financial assistance is to supplement the expenses being incurred on performing Agnihotra Anushthan regularly by the Agnihotris. Priority is given to those who are very aged but still perform Agnihotra on regular basis.
- 10.13.2. During the year 2022-2023 financial assistance of Rs. 18.88 lakh was paid by the Pratishthan to 43 Nityagnihotris at the rate of Rs. 4000/- per month.

#### 10.14. TAPE RECORDING OF VEDIC RECITATION

10.14.1. Under the joint auspices of Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan and Savitribhai Phule Pune University, recording of recitation of Veda Śākhās was done and 40 DVDs were prepared. Details are as follows-

**Veda Śākhā Darśan -**21 DVDs have been prepared in this project. Through this, it will be possible to practice the different styles of chanting the same branches, to study the process of showing different movements for chanting. Texts read in the Mūla Saṃhitā, Vikritipāth and traditional intonation will get reflected in these audios.

**Veda Puruşa Darśan -**Altogether 19 DVDs have been produced in this project. In this, the scholars of different branches have been interviewed. In these interviews, information has been compiled regarding the characteristics of various branches, personal lives, ways to preservation of Veda Śākhās etc.. Due to non-availability of expert Vedic scholars in some branches, recording in these branches is pending.

#### 10.15. VEDA EDUCATION FROM HOME

10.15.1. The Pratishthan has a correspondence course "Ghar Baithe Vedon Ki Shiksha". Those who pass the examination are awarded "Ved Nipun" certificate under this scheme. Syllabus has been formulated as an out-reach programme for the public for basic awareness in four Vedas, Vedang, Brahmin Granth, Aranyak, Upnishad, importance and form of Indian culture, Indian Philosophy. To make the syllabus interesting, Vedic stories have been included and given at appropriate places. So far 1266 persons have taken part in this correspondence course conducted by Prathishthan.

### 10.16. REFRESHER COURSE FOR QUALITY IMPROVEMENT OF VEDA TEACHERS

10.16.1 Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Ved Vidya Pratishthan, Ujjain conducts refresher courses for Veda teachers of all Ved Pathashalas affiliated to the Prathishtan for quality improvement and skill development and also to bring uniformity in Vedic education. Vedic teachers have been availing the benefit by participating in these courses. Two training programmes were organized during the year under report for quality improvement.

### 10.17. RASHTRIYA ADARSH VEDA VIDYALAYA (RAVV)

10.17.1 For preservation and promotion of the Vedas, a well-equipped Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya has been started in the campus of the Pratishthan with high ideals of imparting traditional Vedic education along with its inherent scientific knowledge in a proper manner.

The establishment of Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya was conceptualised in the year 1998. In the Governing Council meeting held on 25 October 1998, it was decided

to establish five Adarsh Veda Vidyalayas of the Pratishthan's own during the Ninth Five Year Plan.

The Pratishthan has been striving for the establishment of the Adarsh Veda Vidyalayas for the last 20 years.

The policy guidelines prepared by the Pratishthan were approved in the Governing Council meeting held on 14 December, 2017 and 24 May, 2018, according to which the Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalayas will be run purely on contractual model. Accordingly, Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya, in Pratishthan campus was inaugurated on 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2018 by the Chairman of the Pratishthan, Hon'ble HRD Minister Shri Prakash Javadekar Ji.

Starting from the year 2018-19, the students who passed Ved Bhushan (fifth year) were given admission in Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya in the first year of Ved Vibhushan on the basis of merit. No fee is charged for admission to Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya. It is a residential vidyalaya. Hostel arrangement for the students is available (Aruni Bhawan). All expenses incurred on the students are borne by the Pratishthan from grants released by the Government of India.

Life in Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya is highly disciplined and is based on Vedic culture and tradition. Students dress in traditional attire of dhoti, shawl etc.which are provided by the Pratishthan. Apart from Vedas, students are also taught subjects like Sanskrit, English, Mathematics, Science, General Science, Computer, Yoga, Music etc. In Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya, recitation of 9 available branches in the oral tradition of Vedas is being taught. In the session 2022-23, admission of students in various branches of Vedas is as under:-

Efforts are being made to run Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya with full student strength. There are 13 teachers of Vedas, 6 teachers of Sanskrit and modern subjects and 4 employees working as support staff in the RAVV, Ujjain.

### 10.18. SETTING UP FIVE NEW RASHTRIYA ADARSH VEDA VIDYALAYAS

10.18.1 Process to establish five Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalayas in five places of the country - Dwarka in Gujarat, Badrinath in Uttarakhand, Guwahati (Assam) in North-Eastern Region, Puri in Odisha and Shringeri or nearby place in Karnataka where 10-15 acres of land is available is continuing. High quality Vedic education will be imparted in these Veda Vidyalyas.

### 10.18.2 Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya, Puri

Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedvidya Pratisthan, Ujjain is an autonomous organisation of the Ministry of Education, Government of India. Hon'ble Minister of Education, Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, Government of India, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan is the Hon'ble Chairman of the Pratishthan and Prof. Prafulla Kumar Mishra is the Hon'ble Vice Chairman of the Pratishthan. Sri Jagannath Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Education Minister and Chairman of the Pratishthan on 4-10-2022 at Puri (Odisha). On this occasion, Hon'ble MLA of Puri region Shri Jayant Kumar Shadangi, Vice Chancellor of Central Sanskrit University, Prof. Shrinivasa Varakhedi, former Vice Chancellor of Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeeth, Prof. Harekrishna Satpathy, Collector of Puri- Shri Samarth Verma, IAS, and other distinguished guests were present.

On this occasion, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan Ji, Hon'ble Minister of Education, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship of the Government of India participated in the Yajna program for the welfare of all the countrymen and the nation.

With a view to Vedic education through oral tradition and preservation, development and propagation of traditional Vedic knowledge and for study of all branches of Vedas along with modern subjects like Sanskrit, Science,

Mathematics, Vedic Mathematics, Sociology, English, Computer, Yoga – Shri Jagannath Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya – with all facilities was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister of Education, Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, Government of India and Hon'ble Chairman of the Pratishthan Shri Dharmendra Pradhan Ji at Lord Shri Jagannath Dham, Puri in Odisha on 4.10.2022 in the Central Sanskrit University's Sri Sadashiva Campus, Odisha. Prof. Prafulla Kumar Mishra, Hon'ble Vice Chairman of the Pratishthan was also present on the occasion.

With the dynamism of Hon'ble Minister of Education, Skill Development and Entrepreneurship of the Government of India and Chairman of the Pratishthan, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan Ji, the vision of the Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji to establish Shri Jagannath Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya at Puri has been realized. New facilities like science lab, computer lab, e-class/digital class etc. will also be provided gradually in this Veda Vidyalaya. Emphasis will be given to all round personality development of the Veda students along with skill development and technical training.

Establishment of Shri Jagannath Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya in Shri Jagannath Dham, Puri, was the vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Ji. It is a huge task for the entire state of Odisha and this day deserves to be written in golden letters. The people of Puri and the preservers of Veda-Sanskrit education and Indian knowledge system of the state of Odisha, deserve commendation.

This day will be a very important day in Odisha for promoting higher studies in all branches of the Vedas, studies in Sanskrit and Indian Knowledge System as per National Education Policy-2020. The initiatives taken by Shri Dharmendra Pradhan Ji, the Hon'ble Chairman of the Pratishthan will be remembered again and again. Will be done. Vedic education will be given a new direction by inclusion of modern subjects to the curriculum. As per the plan and programme of the Hon'ble Education Minister and Chairman of the Pratishthan, total five Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalayas - one each in the Chardhams of the country and one in the North-Eastern State - 1) Puri (Odisha), 2) Shringeri (Karnataka), 3) Dwarka (Gujarat), 4) Badrinath (Uttarakhand), 5) Guwahati (Assam) - will be established.

The Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya at Puri is the first of the five new Rashtriya Adarsha Veda Vidyalayas to be set up, which has been inaugurated on 4/10/2022 at Lord Shri Jagannath Dham, Puri in Odisha by Hon'ble Union Education Minister, Government of India, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan Ji.

In this vidyalaya, admission is given to students in Veda Bhushan IV (Class 9th) and Vth (Class 10th) and Veda Vibhushan I (Class 11th) and II year (Class 12th). Twenty nine students have taken admission in the 2022-23 session. Shri Jagannath Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya, Puri will organize skill development programs, computer training, temple management etc. for the Veda students and

training on correct intonation of Vedas for those performing pujas in temples since the Vedas are the foundation of the Indian Knowledge System.

In this vidyalaya traditional Vedic education along with modern subjects - Sanskrit, Yoga, Science, Mathematics, Vedic Mathematics, Social Science, Computer, English language are being imparted by providing free accommodation and food to the students. Engagement of teachers of modern subjects is under process. Practice of Vedic agricultural is also being introduced.

### 10.18.3 Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya, Dwarka

For Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya, Dwarka, selection of Veda teachers has been completed and one Veda teacher has joined. The building provided by the Dwarka Municipality will be renovated to start Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya and classes will be run for Veda Bhushan IV (Class 9<sup>th</sup>) and V (Class 10<sup>th</sup>) and Veda Vibhushan I (Class 11<sup>th</sup>) and II (Class 12<sup>th</sup>). Applications have been invited for admission of students.

Hon'ble Chairman had written a letter to the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat for allocation of land and for providing temporary accommodation. With prompt cooperation from the Government of Gujarat the process for allotting 26 acres of land in Baradiya village was initiated very quickly. The District Collector has taken necessary steps for handing over possession of the land.

### 10.18.4 Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya, Guwahati

For Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya, Guwahati, selection of Veda teachers has been completed and two teachers have joined who are engaged in making all arrangements for starting RAVV, Guwahati in temporary/rented accommodation. Applications have been invited for admission of students.

Hon'ble Chairman had written a letter to the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam for allocation of land and for providing temporary accommodation. On availability of temporary govt. accommodation or rented accommodation RAVV, Guwahati will be in started by admission of students in Veda Bhushan IV (Class 9<sup>th</sup>) and V (Class 10<sup>th</sup>) and Veda Vibhushan I (Class 11<sup>th</sup>) and II (Class 12<sup>th</sup>).

The allotment of land by the Government of Assam is under process.

### 10.18.5 Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya, Shringeri

Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya, Shringeri will be started by getting a vacant government building in or around Shringeri or by getting a building on rent. RAVV, Shringeri classes will be started by giving admission in Veda Bhushan IV (Class 9<sup>th</sup>) and V (Class 10<sup>th</sup>) and Veda Vibhushan I (Class 11<sup>th</sup>) and II (Class 12<sup>th</sup>). Applications have been invited for admission of students.

#### 10.18.6 Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya Uttarakhand (Badrinath)

In view of the landslides around Sri Badrinath Dham, Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya, Uttarakhand (Badrinath) will be started in Rishikesh or in nearby areas by admitting students in Veda Bhushan IV (Class 9<sup>th</sup>) and V (Class 10<sup>th</sup>) and Veda Vibhushan I (Class 11<sup>th</sup>) and II (Class 12<sup>th</sup>). Applications have been invited for admission of students.

Hon'ble Chairman had written a letter to the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Uttarakhand for allocation of land and for providing temporary accommodation. On availability of temporary govt. accommodation or rented accommodation RAVV, Uttarakhand will be started.

Selection of teachers is being done. The allotment of land by the Government of Uttarakhand is under process.

### 11. THIRD PARTY EVALUATION OF RASHTRIYA ADARSH VEDA VIDYALAYA, UJJAIN.

11.1 The second meeting of the third party/independent evaluation committee for continuation of the Rashtriya Adarsh Veda Vidyalaya operating in the Pratishthan campus, Ujjain was held on December 30 and 31, 2021 in physical presence/online medium at the Pratishthan campus, Ujjain. The first meeting of the Evaluation Committee was held on 17 March 2021 in New Delhi through online medium/ physical presence.

Based on the recommendation of the Third Party Evaluation Committee and instructions received from the Ministry, approval of the Standing Finance Committee has been obtained for continuation of the Rashtriya Adarsh Ved Vidyalaya being run in the Pratishthan premises for the next five years from 2023 onwards.

#### 12. ACTIVITIES OF THE VEDA RESEARCH CENTRE

12.1 The General Body of the Pratishthan, in its 24<sup>th</sup> meeting held in New Delhi on 12<sup>th</sup> July, 2017, approved the setting up of Veda Research Centre in MSRVVP campus. The Governing Council of the Pratishthan in its 38th meeting held in New Delhi on 24-5-2018 implemented the decision to set up Veda Research Centre. In the 43rd meeting of the Governing Council held in New Delhi on 20-7-2020, the Hon'ble Education Minister and Chairman of the Pratishthan, advised that while carrying out research in the field of Veda and Sanskrit there should be collaboration with scholars/professors/scientists of different fields. Hon'ble Education Minister had also advised that a directory of topics on which researches are being conducted at international level may be prepared and initiatives may be taken to conduct research in the fields of Veda and World Peace, Vedic Intonation and its Impact on the Human Brain, Veda and Human Psychology, Veda and Universal Prosperity, Veda and Holistic Development, Veda and Water Preservation, Cosmos and Astrophysics, Vedic Mathematics, Earth Science, Metallurgy, Life Science,

Ayurveda and Yoga, Environmental Science, Veda and Humanity, Ethics, Veda and Management, Health Management, Astronomy, Geo-Hydrology, Zoology etc.

Activities of the Research Center are being organized in compliance with the instructions given and the National Education Policy 2020. This continued in 2022-23 also.

- Online Veda sessions are being conducted by the Veda Research Centre in the last week of every month on various topics.
  - 1. National webinar on 'Geology in the Vedas' was held on 28April 2022 in which Dr. Pradeep Tarnekar, M.Sc., Ph.D., F.G.G.S., F.M.G.S., Environmental Geologist, Indore was the key speaker. Overall, 102 candidates participated in the webinar.
  - 2. National webinar on 'Concept of medical science in Atharvaveda' was held on 28 may 2022 in which Prof.Shatrughan Panigrahi, Department of Vedas, Shri Jagannath Sanskrit University, Puri was the key speaker. Overall, 105 candidates participated in the webinar.
  - 3. National webinar on 'Analysis of Sāmaveda and Sāmagāna' was held on 30 June 2022 in which Venkatraman Bhatt, Samvedacharya, Kendriya Vidyalaya, Bengaluru was the key speaker. Overall, 75 candidates participated in the webinar.
  - 4. National webinar on 'Concept of Climate change in Vedas' was held on 30 July 2022 in which Benudhar Dash, RAVV, MSRVVP, Ujjain was the key speaker. Overall, 88 candidates participated in the webinar.
  - 5. National webinar on 'Thoughts on the subject of Democracy in the Vedas' was held on 24 August, 2022 in which Dr. Sundar Naraya Jha, Deptt. of Veda, SLBSNSU, New Delhi, was the key speaker. Overall, 78 candidates participated in the webinar.
  - 6. National webinar on 'Discussion of Kālanirṇaya in Vedas and Puranic Śāstras' was held on 30 September, 2022, in which Shri Arun Kumar Upadhyay, Retd. IPS Officer, Bhubaneswar, Odisha was the key speaker. Overall, 83 candidates participated in the webinar.
  - 7. National webinar on 'Atharvavedic Medicinal Plants: Names and Applications' was held on 31 October, 2022, in which Dr. Mithilesh Kumar Pandey, RAVV, MSRVVP, Ujjain was the key speaker. Overall, 65 candidates participated in the webinar.
  - 8. National webinar on 'Scientific thought of Mathematics in the Vedas' was held on 25 November, 2022, in which Shri Ayush Shukla, RAVV, MSRVVP, Ujjain was the key speaker. Overall, 65 candidates participated in the webinar.
  - 9. National webinar on 'Vedic studies in different States of India: An overview' was held on 27 December, 2022 in which Prof. Diwakar Mahapatra, Former

- Acharya, Department of Veda, Sri Jagannath Sanskrit University, Puri was the key speaker. Overall, 58 candidates participated in the webinar.
- 10. National webinar on 'Status of Yajña Tradition in Ancient and Modern India: In Vedic Perspective' was held on 31 January, 2023, in which Dr. Niranjan Mishra, Dept. of Vedabhashyam, NSU, Tirupati was the key speaker. Overall, 65 candidates participated in the webinar.
- 11. National webinar on 'Worship of Pitṛdevatā in world literature' was held on 17 February, 2023, in which Prof. Brajakishore Swain, Dept. of Dharmashashtra, Sri Jagannath Sanskrit University, Puri, was the key speaker. Overall, 47 candidates participated in the webinar.
- 12. National webinar on 'Maharṣi Aurobindo's vision of Veda'was held on 24 March, 2023, in which Prof. Ramraj Upadhyay, Dept. of Paurohitya, SLBNSU, New Delhi,was the key speaker. Overall, 48 candidates participated in the webinar.

### 13. ACTIVITIES OF VEDA TRAINING CENTRE

13.1 The Governing Council of the Pratishthan, in its 42<sup>nd</sup> meeting, approved training of the Vedapathis and the Veda students under the guidance of renowned Vedic scholars for improving the quality of Veda education in Oral Tradition. For mainstreaming of the Veda students Pratishthan must include modern subjects like Mathematics, English, Science, Social Science etc. in its syllabus. The Governing Council also directed that adequate facilities may be provided to the Veda students to enable them to understand the meaning of the Veda texts and are in a position to spread the oral tradition of Vedic education.

The Veda training Centre of the Pratishthan is conducting various refresher course training programmes for Veda teachers as well as modern subject teachers of the financially affiliated Veda Pathashalas and the Guru Shishya Pararampara (GSP) Units.

### 14. PREPARING TEXT BOOKS FOR THE STUDENTS OF VEDA BHUSHAN AND VEDA VIBHUSHAN

#### 14.1 Examinations for Veda Bhushan and Veda Vibhushan

Every year Pratishthan conducts examinations for the students of Veda Bhushan 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> std (Prathama/Eqvt.of 8<sup>th</sup> std), 4<sup>th</sup>& 5<sup>th</sup> std (Madhyama/Eqvt.of 10<sup>th</sup>std) and for students of Veda Vibhushan 1st & 2nd year (Uttar Madhyam/ Eqvt.of 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> std). More than 7000 students appear in these examinations every year. A number of universities have recognized the courses and examinations of the Pratishthan for admission into higher education. List of these universities is given in Annexure-11.

### 14.2 Preparation of Text books of various subjects

In terms of the decision of the 42<sup>nd</sup> meeting of the Governing Council of the Pratishthan for mainstreaming of the Veda students, the hidden knowledge in

Vedas have to be brought out and aligned with the Pratishthan's syllabus of modern subjects. It was also directed that proper system may be evolved to enable the traditional Veda students to understand the meaning of the Veda shlokas, and practice and propagate them. Hon'ble Education Minister and Chairman of the Pratishthan also directed that the Veda students of the Pratishthan may be taught modern science along side Veda and for that purpose necessary textbooks may be prepared.

In compliance of the directions of the Governing Council initiatives have been taken to prepare the text books on Sanskrit, Mathematics, English, Science, Social Science, Computer, Yoga etc. to enhance the quality of education of the students of Veda Bhushan and Veda Vibhushan courses of the Pratishthan during the year under report. The text books are being prepared in line with NEP 2020.

### 15. ADVANCED COURSES IN VEDA ON PADA, KRAMA, GHANA, JATA ETC.

Deliberating on the objectives of preservation, development and propagation of the oral tradition of Vedic studies for establishment of the Pratishthan, the Governing Council of the Pratishthan, in its 42<sup>nd</sup> meeting, emphasized the need for introducing the courses of Pada, Krama, Jata, Ghana etc. to fulfill the madate of the Pratishthan.

Accordingly, keeping in view the objectives of the Pratishthan to preserve the various Vedic traditions, the Governing Council approved the introduction of the above courses alongwith other courses of Brahmana-Grantha, Pratishakhya, Veda Bhashya, Vedanga etc. with highest degree of quality parameters.

### 16. MAHARSHI SANDIPANI RASHTRIYA VEDA SANSKRIT SHIKSHA BOARD

The General Body and the Governing Council of the Pratishthan have approved the setting up of Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Sanskrit Shiksha Board and its model Bye-Laws under Rule 14 (iv)(f) of the MoA & Rules of the Pratishthan for standardization, examination, affiliation recognition, certification and authentication as well as strengthening of Gurukula system of oriental studies and Veda Sanskrit education up to Pre-degree/Sr. Secondary level in the country.

Academic jurisdiction of this All India Board will be i) Veda Pathashlas with oral tradition; ii) Guru Shishya Parampara (GSP) Units; iii) Pathashalas with full-time Sanskrit studies with other oriental studies; iv) Morning-evening part-time Veda/Sanskrit Pathashalas; v) Sanskrit medium schools imparting Veda/Sanskrit education along with other oriental and modern subjects; vi) Traditional oriental vidyalayas teaching Veda/Sanskrit alongwith syllabus as per NEP 2020.

Apart from these, Indian knowledge system/Indian traditional fourteen academic streams such as Veda, Vedabhashya, Vedanga, Puran, Dharmashatra and Philosophy etc. and their alignment with modern subjects like Science, Mathematics, Social Science etc. up to the level of Pre-degree/Sr. Secondary school education and all matters relating to the scheme of the Ministry of Education to modernize the Veda/Sanskri Pathashalas will be looked after by the Board.

The Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Sanskrit Shiksha Board will start functioning from the date the Govt of India notifies the setting up of the Board in terms of Rule 14(iv)(f) of the Pratishthan. Headquarters of the Board will be Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Paratishthan campus at Ujjain and the Pratishthan will be the controlling authority of the Board. As per provisions in the Bye-Laws of the Board, its activities can be started by hiring manpower on contractual basis.

The Model Bye-Laws, Examination Bye-Laws, Affiliation Bye-Laws, Academic Bye-Laws etc. of the Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Sanskrit Shiksha Board have been submitted to the Ministry of Education during the year 2022-2023. Regular correspondence with the Ministry is on for notification at the earliest.

# Establishment of Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Sanskrit Shiksha Board and grant of recognition by the Govt. of India as equivalent of 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Std School Board Examination.

The Department of School Education & Literacy, vide its Notification No. No.11-3 / 2016-Sch 3 dated 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2021, published in the Gazette of India in Part I, Section I authorized the Association of the Indian Universities (AIU) as the competent authority to grant equivalence to the certificates/degrees awarded by the various Boards/universities to that of 10<sup>th</sup> & 12 std Examination.

Department of Higher Education, undertook effective consulation with the Department of School Education & Literacy, NCERT, CBSE regarding the model bye-laws, affiliation bye-laws, examination bye-laws and on the syllabus/course curriculum and obtained their approval. The syllabus and course curriculum of the MSRVSS Board was examined and vetted by NCERT and the affiliation bye-laws examination bye-laws were examined and vetted by CBSE.

#### **Recognition by Association of Indian Universities (AIU)**

AIU vide its letter No. AIU/EV/IN(I)2022/MSRVSSB dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2022 granted recognition to the course curriculum and the examinations of MSRVSS Board as equivalent of 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Std Secondary and Higher Secondary School Board Examination of Central and various State School Boards for admission to higher educational institutions and for employment purposes.

The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) vide its circular No.AICTE/P&AP/Misc./2022/ dated 13.09.2022 recognised the course curriculum and the examinations of MSRVSS Board as equivalent of 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Std Secondary and Higher Secondary School Board Examination of Central and various State School Boards for admission to higher educational institutions and for employment purposes.

In terms of Para 1 (f) of the bye-laws, the MSRVSS Board has been established Ministry of Education Notification No.3-14/2018--skt I, dated 8-8-2022. Now the Veda Bhushan and Veda Vibhushan certficates awarded by the MSRVSS

Board are recognized qualifications for admission to higher educational institutions and for employment in Central and State Governments

#### 17. VEDA PARAYAN OF ALL VEDA SHAKHAS IN BADRINATH.

In order to reach out to the general public with the message of traditional Vedic recitations, as envisaged in the objectives of the Pratishthan, a programme of Recitation of All branches of the Vedas (Sarva Veda shakha Parayan) was organized for the local residents of Badrinath in AtharvaVedaPeeth of Badrinath Dham established by Bhagwan Shri Sankaracharya Dham which is situated in a remote locality. Prof. Prafulla Kumar Mishra, Hon'ble Vice Chairman of the Pratishthan, and Vedic scholars from RAVV and other affiliated Veda Pathashalas participated in the programme.

# 18. INAUGURATION OF "MAHAKAL CORRIDOR" AND PARTICIPATION OF VEDA TEACHERS AND STUDENTS OF THE RAY, UJJAIN.

For renovation of the Lord Mahakal temple complex, Mahakal corridor has been constructed which was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Shri Narendra Modi Ji 11th October, 2022 evening. On this auspicious occasion, under the guidance of Secretary, MSRVVP and other Veda scholars, the Veda teachers and the students of the RAVV, Ujjain performed Veda recitation in the presence of Hon'ble Prime Minister of India.

# 19. "SUMANGALAM – SUJALAM JAL MAHOTSAV" AND VEDA PARAYAN OF FOUR VEDAS, ORGANISED JOINTLY BY THE PRATISHTHAN AND THE MAHAKAL TEMPLE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE.

The Veda Parayan of the four Vedas in the above programme was organized in the Mahakal temple complex with participation of reknowned Vedic scholars as under:

From 5-12-2022 to 11-12-2022, Rig Veda Parayan was conducted by Sh Umakant Samanta from Puri, Shri Giridhari Mahapatra from Alwar, Shri Vikash Pandey from Gaziabad, Shri Pushkar Lal Sharma from Harda, Shri Satyam Shukla and other Veda students from RAVV, Ujjain.

From 12.12.2022 to 17.12.2022, Shukla YajurVeda Madhyandini Shakha Parayan conducted by Shri Radheshyam Pathak from RAVV, Ujjain, Shri Swapnil Lakhe, Shri Akash Rawal, Shri Sheshnath Tiwari and other Veda students.

From 18.12.2022 to 22.12.2022, Sam Veda Parayan was conducted by Dr Jayprakash Dwivedi, Shri Mahendra Nath, Shri Shrimisthan Shrouti and others.

From 23.12.2022 to 27.12.2022, Atharva Veda Parayan was conducted by Shri Mithilesh Kumar Pandey, Shri Hrishikesh Pandey, Shri Dharmendra Sharma and other Veda students.

On 28.12.2022, on the auspicious occasion of Sumangalam- Sujalam- Jal Mahotsav, Sarsanghchalak of Rashtriya Swayam Sevak Sangh, Hon'ble Shri Mohan Bhagwat Ji unveiled a silver obelisk in the Mahakal temple complex and delivered an inspiring speech for preservation and purity of water.

# 20. ASSESSMENT OF QUALITY IN VEDA RECITATION WITH INTONATION THROUGH THE APPLICATION OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE-MACHINE LEARNING

For achieving the objective of preservation, development and propagation of the oral tradition of Vedic studies, Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan has been providing financial assistance for the last thirty five years. to the Veda Pathashalas and Guru Shishya Prarampara (GSP) Units located in various states in the country by way of honorarium to the teachers and stipend to the Veda students. Simultaneously, for spreading the message of Vedic awareness and Vedic way of life, various other programmes such as Veda Sammelans, Veda Seminars/ Workshops, Veda Sandesh Yatra, Ved Gyan Saptah etc. are also organized by the Pratishthan. For providing knowledge of science and technology to the Veda students Pratishthan has also been paying honorarium for the teachers for teaching modern subjects in these Pathashalas.

In compliance of Ministry's letter dated 16-01-2023 a project was taken up for assessment of quality in Vedic recitation with intonation through the application of artificial intelligence and machine learning. A model software was developed and presented before the officials in the Ministry on 21-01-2023. Thereafter, a detailed project proposal was submitted to the Ministry for providing budgetary support. Approval of the Ministry of Education, Govt. of Inida has been received for Rs. 7.50 crore for the project. which has been approved

# 21. ALIGNMENT OF VEDIC COURSES OF THE PRATISHTHAN WITH NATIONAL CURRICULUM FOR VOCATIONAL EDUCATION & TRAINING.

In the 45th meeting of the Governing Council of the Pratishthan held on 2-1-2023 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Education Minister and Chairman of the Pratishthan, Hon'ble Chairman directed that for enhancement of employability of the Veda students, it is highly essential for them to learn various temple rituals, mantrapath, architecture, astrology and other traditional Indian skills along with their study of Veda and its preservation and propagation.

Keeping this purpose in mind the Hon'ble Chairman directed the Pratishthan to conduct various training programmes on weekly and monthly basis on temple management and rituals, astrology, architecture etc. for the Veda students of the Pratishthan. Further, the Hon'ble Chairman also directed the Pratishthan to submit a proposal through the Ministry of Education for alignment of the Vedic courses of the Pratishthan with the skill development programmes of the National Council for Vocational Education and Training.

In compliance of the above direction of the Hon'ble Chairman and the Governing Council Pratishthan has submitted a proposal to National Council for Vocational Education and Training through the Ministry vide its letter 17-02-2023.

**ANNEXURES 2022-2023** 

#### **OBJECTIVES OF THE PRATISHTHAN**

In order to fulfil the following objectives, the Pratishthan has been established:-

- 1. To preserve, conserve and develop the oral tradition of Vedas, for which the Pratishthan will undertake various activities such as to provide financial assistance to traditional Vedic institutions and scholars / Vedapathis, provide fellowships/scholarship, undertake preparation of audio/video tapes, etc.
- 2. To foster the tradition of intonation and recitation through learned scholars and Pandits.
- 3. To encourage and ensure involvement of dedicated students in higher research in the field.
- 4. To provide research facilities to those students having background of Vedic knowledge and to equip them with sufficient scientific and analytical outlook, so that modern scientific thoughts contained in the Vedas, particularly disciplines of mathematics, astronomy, meteorology, chemistry, hydraulics, etc. should be linked with modern science and technology so that a rapport between them and modern scholars could be established.
- 5. To establish Vedic Pathashala and research centres, takeover, manage or supervise throughout the country to fulfil and maintain any objectives of the Pratishthan.
- 6. To revive and administer such of the endowments and trusts as are dysfunctional, or aren't run properly.
- 7. To pay special attention to those Shakhas which are extinct and for which human repositories can be identified, and to prepare a detailed list of Pandits related to these Shakhas.
- 8. To ascertain the present status of affairs of oral traditions in respect of Vedas, particularly intonation and recitation peculiar to various regions, institutions and maths in the country.
- 9. To collect information that whether original state of textual material, printed manuscripts, texts, commentaries and interpretations, etc. of the various oral traditions of Vedic Shakhas are available or unavailable.
- 10. To collect information about the present state of recordings, both audio and visual, available in the country.
- 11. To undertake research, in the interest of advancement of scientific knowledge, in Vedic texts and Vedic Literature from the earliest time of Vedic period up to the present day including areas of science, agriculture, technology, philosophy, yoga, education, poetics, grammar, linguistics and Vedic tradition and to provide for library, research equipment, research facilities, supporting staff and other technical manpower;.
- 12. To undertake all such activities as may be necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any one of the objectives of the Pratishthan, in accordance with the Memorandum of Association.
