Do all animals and birds build themselves permanent homes to which they return every day to sleep, eat or play in, as you do? The answer is 'No'! They generally build homes for two reasons. First, to bring up their families and second to escape danger from bad weather or enemies. Termites are probably the very earliest social insects. You probably have heard of termites when your mother says, "Our wooden shelves have been chewed up again!" Termites usually build their nests in soil or wood. They use the chewed wood as food for themselves and their babies. Some species produce detailed structures with systems of internal cavities and galleries. The nest is usually made of material formed after soil is mixed with the termite's saliva and allowed to dry and harden. Termites have a highly-developed social structure consisting of workers, soldiers, king and queen. The queen termite lives in her chamber along with the king. She produces thousands of eggs a day until she builds up a colony of over a million. All the while she is fed and attended to by her workers who also remove the eggs to separate brood chambers, and feed the larvae.
