1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. The Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan was established in January 1987 by the Department of Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi. It is an autonomous organisation registered under the Societies' Registration Act, 1860. The objectives of the Pratishthan are as under :
- (A) Preservation, conservation and development of the oral tradition of Vedic studies.
- (B) Study of the Vedas through Pathashalas as well as other means and institutions.
- (C) Creation and promotion of research facilities so as to bring out the rich wealth of knowledge contained in the Vedas and to relate it with the contemporary needs.
- (D) Collection of information and to arrange basic facilities to store relevant material and to disseminate and publish it in various forms using different resources.
- 1.2. The Objectives of the Pratishthan as given in the Memorandum of Association are appended at Annexure I.
- 1.3. The office of the Pratishthan was shifted to Ujjain in May 1993 and it was renamed as "Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan".

2. AUTHORITIES OF PRATISHTHAN

2.1 General Body and Governing Council are the Authorities of the Pratishthan. In accordance with its Memorandum of Association and Rules and Regulations, the various powers and functions for carrying out the affairs of the Pratishthan are vested in its General Body and Governing Council. Hon'ble Union Minister for Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi is the Chairman for General Body and Governing Council both. The General Body is vested with the general power for reviewing the broad policies and programmes of the Pratishthan. It also suggests measures for its improvement and development. The Governing Council is the principal executive body of the Pratishthan and responsible for the general superintendence, direction and control of its affairs.

- 2.2 There is a provision in the rules of the Pratishthan for "Finance Committee". The Finance Committee is headed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chairman. The Committee is responsible for all matters pertaining to the management of the properties and investments, preparation of estimates for annual budget and statements of accounts and expenditure of the Pratishthan.
- 2.3 Under its general powers, the Pratishthan has constituted a Project Committee, which comprises members of eminent scholars of Veda and related subjects for consideration of its academic projects and programmes. The composition of the present Project Committee is given at Annexure II.
- 2.4 The General Body, Governing Council and the Finance Committee were reconstituted by the Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi for a term of five years on May 22, 2010. The composition of these bodies are given at Annexure III, as it was notified by the Government of India on May 22, 2010. These bodies continued to function during the year under report.

3. OFFICERS OF THE PRATISHTHAN

- 3.1 There is a provision for a Chairman as head of the Pratishthan under rules of the Pratishthan. The Chairman is to be nominated by the Government of India for a term of 5 years. He presides over the meetings of the General Body and Governing Council. Hon'ble Cabinet Minister, Ministry for Human Resource Development, Government of India, is a Chairman of the Pratishthan at present.
- 3.2 The rules of the Pratishthan also provide a clause for a Vice Chairman to be nominated by the Chairman. The Vice Chairman has to perform such duties and exercise such functions and powers as the Chairman may specify generally or in any individual case. Professor S. Sudarshan Sharma, Vice Chairman, Shree Venkateshwar Vedic Vishwavidyalaya, Tirupati is designated on the post of Vice-Chairman of the Pratishthan since 24.05.2010.
- 3.3 There is a provision in rules and regulations of the Pratishthan that there should be a full time salaried Chief Academic & Executive Officer who will act as a Secretary and he/she shall be the head for academic as well as administrative activities. The Secretary exercises general supervision and controls over the affairs of the Pratishthan and implements all decisions taken by authorities of the Pratishthan.
- 3.4 Professor Roop Kishor Shastri has been appointed as full time Secretary of the Pratishthan by the Government of India and he has taken over the charge as a Secretary of the Pratishthan since 05.01.2011.

4. OTHER OFFICERS AND STAFF

4.1 In pursuance of the recommendations of its Internal Work Study Unit, the Department of Education had on 14.8.98 accorded sanction of the Government for creation of one post each of Director, Programme Officer, Section Officer and Accountant as part of interim organisational set-up for the Pratishthan. The Governing Council of the Pratishthan in its

meeting held on 21.2.2000 approved by laws for recruitment of all sanctioned posts of the Pratishthan. With regard to appointment of these posts, the Ministry vide their letter No. 6-10/2010-SKTII dated 13.01.2011 accorded its approval, under which each of the post of director, programme officer, section officer and accountant have been filled up.

- 4.3 In the year under review, work of the Pratishthan related to academic, administrative and financial matters have been carried out under the supervision of Member Secretary. Seven daily wages employees have been appointed on contract basis.

5. HEADQUARTERS

- 5.1 The headquarters of the Pratishthan have been shifted from Pradhikaran Bhavan, Bharatpuri to Prashasanik Bhavan, Chintaman Ganesh, Veda Vidya Marg, P.O. Jawasiya, Ujjain (M.P.) on 12-12-2012.
- 5.2 During the meeting of Standing Finance Committee held on 18-12-2007, the construction of buildings and development of land premises were considered and sanction of estimated Rs. 25.02 crores was granted. On this basis, the Central Public Works Department submitted various maps to the Pratisthan, which were sanctioned by the Pratishthan in March 2008. The construction of administrative building and development of premises, had been completed

and handed over to the Pratishthan by the Central Public Works Department, Indore during the year 2012-13. The construction work of officers and employees quarters have been under taken which is under progress.

6. CORPUS FUND OF THE PRATISHTHAN

- 6.1 At the time of establishment of the Pratishthan, Government had envisaged that a Corpus Fund of Rupees Ten Crores would be placed at its disposal so that recurring income from its investment may be utilised for financing various activities and programmes of the Pratishthan. A sum of Rupees Ten Crores was provided by the Government in instalments by the end of year 1996-97 for this purpose.
- 6.2 As per decision taken on 18-10-2001 in the meeting of the Finance Committee, a sum of Rs. 10, 51, 44, 931.74 lying in the general fund has been added in the Corpus Fund. During the year 2014-15, the Corpus Fund has total sum of Rs. 20, 51, 44, 931.74.

7. NEW PROGRAMMES APPROVED

- 7.1 The Standing Finance Committee (SFC) of the Government of India in its meeting held on 24.11.98 had considered proposal of the Pratishthan for enhancement of its Corpus Fund. After detailed discussion, the Committee was satisfied about the need and justification for enhanced requirement of funds by the Pratishthan for sustaining the on-going programmes and to introduce new academic programmes which are required to fulfil objectives of the Pratishthan.
- 7.2 The Standing Finance Committee (SFC) decided to provide the additional requirement of funds by annual budgetary support from the Government instead of through enhancement of Corpus Fund. It was also emphasized by SFC that the Pratishthan's activities and Programmes would not be allowed to suffer due to paucity of funds and the budgetary allocations would be protected. In accordance with the decision of SFC, the Department of Education under the Ministry of HRD released Rupees 25.00 Crores during 2014-15 as grant-in-aid to the Pratishthan towards additional expenditure for on-going programmes, but grant-in-aid of Rs. 24.00 Crores had been obtained.
- 7.3 The new academic programmes sanctioned by the SFC have been given below. The status of their implementation obtained during the year under report has been indicated in brackets below, where applicable.
 - (1) Financial assistance to Special Gurukulas for sustenance of Shakhas of Vedas, which are on the verge of extinction. The following Gurukulas have been identified for financial assistance at (a) Trichur [Kerala for Samaveda Jaiminiya Shakha], (b) Baripada, Mayurbhanj [Orissa] for Atharva Veda {Paipplada Shakha} and (c) Guiyahpal, Singhbumi {Jharkhand} for Atharva Veda {Paipplada Shakha}. At present, these Gurukuls have been provided financial assistance under the scheme of "Preservation of oral tradition of vedic recitation". An action has been initiated to identify more Special Gurukulas. As a result of concerted efforts of the Pratishthan, now teachings have been started continuously at Chitrakut (Madhya Pradesh) and Jharkhand, Orissa, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh States in Paippalad Shakha.

- (2) Preservation of Srauta Karma Parampara and its documentation. Presently, action has been initiated to collect video/audio cassettes/CD ROMs of Soma Yajnas and other Yajnas/ Ishtis performed/ to be performed by Non-Government Organizations etc at other places.
- (3) Implementation of publication programmes for bringing out rare and out-of-print Veda Samhitas, Brahmanas granthas and other Vedic literatures. The publication of bi-annual Research Journal "Vedavidya" has been continued. The publication of "Veda Varta" has also been continued since April 2012.
- (4) The programme of correspondence course "Ghar Baithe Vedon ki Shiksha" has been introduced. Its English version has been brought out this year. The object of this course is to dissemminate knowledge of four Vedas, Vedangas, Brahmin Grantha, Aranyaka Grantha, Upnishad and the role and importance of Indian Culture and Philosophy among the common people.
- 7.4 Formulation of comprehensive project reports and/or plan of action for implementation of new programmes continued during the year under report.

9. ON-GOING PROGRAMMES AND ACTIVITIES

9.0 The Pratishthan has been pursuing a number of programmes and activities for the achievement of its objectives enshrined in its Memorandum of Association since its inception. The following programmes and activities were continued by the Pratishthan, during the year under report.

9.1 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO VEDIC INSTITUTIONS

- 9.1.1 The objectives of the Pratishthan are to establish, take over, manage or supervise Vedic Pathashalas /Research Centres in all over the country and to maintain/run them effectively. Under this provision, financial assistance has been provided to various Veda Pathashalas/Vidyalayas in the country.
- 9.1.2 The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi had transferred the scheme of financial assistance along with budgetary allocation to Voluntary Organizations (Veda Pathashalas) for promotion of Vedic education to the Pratishthan for execution with effect from 01-04-1994. Under this scheme, an honorarium to the teachers and stipend to students studying in institution/pathashalas has been provided by the Pratishthan. Now a fresh Veda Teacher gets an honorarium of Rs. 11,000/- per month. A teacher having teaching experience of more than 5 years and more than 10 years gets honorarium@ Rs. 15,000/- per month and@Rs. 17,000/- per month respectively.

- 9.1.3 A Veda student is paid stipend @ Rs. 2000/- p.m., out of which Rs. 1000/- p.m. to be deposited by the Pathashala in the Fixed/ Recurring Deposit in a Nationalised Bank in the name of student as Deferred Stipend Account in accordance with the instructions laid down by the Pratishthan for the purpose. The accumulated amount in the Bank together with interest would be paid to the concerned student in one lump sum on successful completion of his studies. The remaining Rs. 1000/- would be utilized by the Pathashala on maintenance of the student. The Management of the pathashalas are expected that they should arrange the prescribed nutrition standard meal for students and also to provide necessary funds from their own resources for the purpose. It is also expected from the management of pathashala is required to keep proper books of accounts of actual expenditure under the sub-head "Maintenance of students" both in respect of grant-in-aid provided by the Pratishthan as well as the funds utilized by them from their own resources and its utilization duly certified by the Auditors.
- 9.1.4 During the year 2014-15 under report, the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi provided Rs. 2,75,00,000/- (2.75 Crore) to wards grant-inaid to the Pratishthan for the year 2014-15 to meet expenditure on honorarium to Veda teachers and stipend to Veda students in Veda Pathashalas and honorarium of Swadhyayiteachers and stipend of students participating in the scheme of "Preservation of oral tradition of Vedic recitation", on-going projects and construction of new campus.
- 9.1.5 As per prevailing practice, the Pratishthan were invited applications from Vedic Pathashalas/ Vidyalayas, their teachers and students along with all relevant details. The information furnished by the Pathashalas was scrutinized and after satisfactory fulfilment of various conditions and requirements, etc. the grant was released to various pathashalas.
- 9.1.6 During the year 2014-15, Rs. 609.35 lakhs were paid as an honorarium to 407 Veda teachers of 67 Veda Pathashalas/Schools and Rs. 665.97 lakhs were paid as a stipend to 3219 students. Total amount of Rs. 1275.32 lakhs was released to Pathashalas/Vidyalayas during the year under review.
- 9.1.7 During the year 2014-15, total Rs. 150 lakhs were spent towards honorarium to 21 Veda teachers, stipend to 121 students, contingent grant of 4 Veda pathashalas/units located in the North-Eastern States which organized veda conference and veda seminars for dissemination of vedas.
- 9.1.8 A statement of financial assistance provided to Veda Pathashalas/Vidyalayas during 2014-15 consisting quantum of assistance and the purpose for which it was granted, has been furnished at Annexure IV-A & Annexure IV-B.

9.2 EXAMINATION OF STUDENTS OF VEDA PATHASHALAS/VIDYALAYAS

9.2.1 The examiantion for students were conducted at the Veda Pathashalas/Vidyalayas located at different regions of the country under the schemes of Pathashala and Preservationof Oral Tradition of Vedic Recitation (Guru Shishya Parampara). The written and oral examinations of the students from 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th and 7th year were held at the different exam centre under the guidance and supervision of the Exam Superintendent, Centre

Superintendent and the learned scholars from eminent educational institutions like J.R. Rajasthan Sanskrit University (Jaipur), Guwahati University (Guwahati), Vedic Sanshodhan Mandal (Pune), Lucknow University (Lucknow), Shri Lalbahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeeth (Delhi), Gurukul Kangri University (Haridwar), Illahbad University (U.P), Kashi Hindu University (Varanasi), Sampurnanad Sanskrit University (Varanasi), Shastra University (Tanjavur) etc. nominated by the pratishthan.

9.3 SCHEME FOR PRESERVATION OF ORAL TRADITION OF VEDIC RECITATION

- 9.3.1 This Government scheme had been in operation since Fifth Five Year Plan. It had been transferred by the Ministry of Human Resource Development to the Pratishthan since 1.4.1994 for execution. The objective of this scheme is to provide special incentive for preservation of the oral tradition of Vedic recitation. Under this scheme, a Swadhyayi teacher is required to teach students at his residence or at any suitable place in his locality. The selected Swadhyayi teacher for the said purpose is required to possess proficiency at least in one Shakha of the Vedas. He is expected to provide special coaching to the students in recitation specially assigned to him for this purpose, so as to enable them to acquire proficiency in reciting the complete Samhita with Swara of the particula Shakha for which he is qualified. The duration of syllabus is seven years for each student. After completion of syllabus of seven years, certificate of Veda Vibhushan is awarded to vedic student.
- 9.3.2 The parents of the students are required to execute an Indemnity Bond for the value of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties to the effect that they will not withdraw their wards during the course of study for a minimum period of seven years. The scholar-teacher is also required to give an Undertaking to abide with the terms and conditions of the scheme.
- 9.3.3 The grant was provided to 287 units under the Vedic Saswar Yojana during the year under review. Under this scheme, 287 teachers and 3024 vedic students participated and financial assistance of Rs. 851.28 lakhs was provided to them.
- 9.3.4 The grant was provided to 19 units in North-Eastern states under the Vedic Saswar Yojana during the year under review, under which 19 teachers and 152 vedic students participated and financial assistance of Rs. 50.80 lakhs was provided to them.

9.4 CONDUCTION OF VEDIC CLASSES FOR ALL INTERESTED PERSONS

9.4.1 The Pratishthan formulated a scheme to run the vedic classes, for all those persons who have an interest in Vedic studies and disseminate the relevant information, irrespective of their being ineligible / unqualified and have a plan to run vedic class. Under this scheme, 100 lectures are delivered on every Saturday and Sunday in two lectures on special topics of vedas. The structure of syllabus which includes various subjects has been prescribed by the Pratishthan. During the year 2014-15, classes were organized in Sansthan Dharma College, Ambala from (July 12, 2014 to December 28, 2014) in Hariyana, Rajasthan Vidyapeeth university, Udaipur (Rajasthan) form August 2, 2014 to March 2015 and Shri Sankatmochan Hanuman Mandir Trust, Hanuman Setu University Marg, Lucknow (U.P.), from August 16, 2014 to 28 Febuary 2015.

9.5 SEMINARS

9.5.0 In order to encourage scholars for research activities in vedic studies, Seminars are being organized in the thrust areas by the Pratishthan. These seminars are fully or partly financed by the Pratishthan. The Pratishthan provided financial assistance to the following organizations for organizing seminars during the year under report.



9.5.1 A NATIONAL SEMINAR ON "RELEVANCE OF VEDAS AND INDIAN CULTURE IN THE PRESENT PERSPECTIVE" ORGANIZED IN SHIMALA



A Three day National seminar had been organized jointly with Himachal Pradesh University and Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan, Ujjain from 22 to 24 May, 2014. The title of seminar was - Relevance of vedas and Indian Culture in the present perspective'. The researchers and the scholars, belonged to various universities of the country, participated in the seminar. Prof Rajindra Sharma, convener of Vedic seminar expressed her obligation for participation of eminent persons in the welcome address. The programme presided by Achrya Arun Divakar Nath Vajapeyi, vice chancellor of Himachal Pradesh University, was started with Vedic Mantras. With having lightened lamp, he followed the tradition of doing Saraswati vandana and dynasty song and he kept the audience aware of the importance of Veda in human life by his thoughts. Dr. Om Prakash Pandey ji, scientific adviser of former prime minister, chief orator delivered a lecture on mystery of world science. He said that vedas are implied in science, as such there is no any dispute between Veda and science. Vedas are filled with the knowledge of celestial events. Science is proving things which were described in Vedas. Therefore a scientist should have whole knowledge of Sanskrit. This subject attracted the attention of all researcher and eminent scholars.

On second day, Researchers presented the research papers on various subjects of Veda. All most subjects are- Science in Veda, Ayurveda in Veda, Naturopathy in Veda, Ayurveda in Atharva Veda, Astronomy in Veda, Human values in Veda, Women in Veda, Veda and Environment, Vedic Yajna, the role of Vedas to make man, a human. The researchers presented research papers on these subjects. By the experience of these eminent scholars-Dr. Baldeva Anand Sagar, Dr. Lalit Gaur, Dr. Rajeshwar Mishra, De. Vijendra Mishra, Dr. Omprakash Pandey, Prof. Roop Kishor Shastri, Dr. kailash Tiwari, Dr. Kamder Jha, Prof. Amaldhari Singh etc, the researchers were benefited. Prof. Amaldhari Singh Ji provided copies of Shankhayana samhita to Hon'ble vice chancellor and other distinguished guests.

On the last day Prof, Roop Kishor Shastri Ji, secretary of Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan, Ujjain delivered his invaluable thoughts on the relevance of Vedas. After that a three day seminar was concluded by Prof. Rajindra Sharma, convener of seminar proposed a vote of thanks.

9.5.2 NATIONAL SEMINAR ON "VEDIC EXPLANATIONS- PAST AND PRESENT" ORGANIZED IN PUNE

Prof. Roop Kishor Shastri, Pratisththan secretary, chief guest expressing views in the concluding session of `Akhil Bhartiya Vedic Seminar on `Vedic Explanations- past and present`, said that the participants visited from different states and places in jointly organized national seminar in auspices of Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan and progressing Sanskrit study centre Pune university increased its dignity and attracted the attention of all by conveying theme of seminar to various institutions of country so pratishthan expressed its compliments and felicitations. While expressing views on research papers in seminar by scholars, to read vikrati paths by scholars was an inspirational and noble effort which is certainly a praise worthy. In view of universal utility of Vedavidya, it deserves appreciation naturally.

Dr. Dharmendra Kumar, distinguished guest of valedictory function and secretary of Delhi Sanskrit Academy, delivered an effective address on present Veda explanations thematic criterion and procedures in the past perspective. In his presidential lecture Pandit Sadhu Bhadresh, Hon'ble member of Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan Project committee and international veda and Sanskrit scholar of Narayan community Aksardham Gujrat, minutely presented works of veda and Sanskrit thematic and kept apprised of many works. Sadhu Bhadresh Maharaj was praised by all participants, scholars and other people present for his erudition, modesty and amiability. He also stated that Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan achieved its objectives through organizing such type of functions. Having enraptured they stated that then are highly grateful to committee for making this celebration successful. It is hoped. That such type of high level functions would be organized in future through university so that Veda and Sanskrit can be disseminated.

Prof. Ravindra Mule, Director of improving study centre, was a convener of the function and B.K. Dalai delivered a speech. The pratishthan is grateful for success of this celebration to all officers and collaborating students of improving study centre.

9.5.3 A NATONAL SEMINAR ON "VEDIC YAJNA PROCESS "AT MALIGAON, GUWAHATI

The eternal source of existence for commencing the process of generation and growth of cosmic powers, Yajna means selfless sacrificing for noble tasks, "said Mukundakam Sharma, former justice, Supreme court of India and Vice Chancellor, Lalbahadur Shastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeeth, New Delhi, in his inaugural speech of the three day long MHRD sponsored National Seminar on Vedic Yajna Process organized by Blue Hop of Guwahati in collaboration with Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan, Ujjain- an organization under the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India. 9.6 VEDIC SAMMELANS

9.6.0 In order to disseminate Vedic studies and knowledge widely throughout the country, the Vedic Conferences (Sammelans) play a significant role in the programmes of the Pratishthan. In every year, a three day All India Conference and other Regional Vedic Conferences are organized, which include inaugural and valedictory functions. These conferences are organized in collaboration with eminent Vedic institutions, Universities, Vidyapeeths, etc. Where there are no such institutions are available, organizing committee of eminent scholars and prominent persons has been constituted for organizing such conferences. The Pratishthan organized seven Regional and two All India Vedic Conferences during the year 2014-15 under review. The details of the conferences organized by the Pratishthan are appended below.

9.6.1 SAMAVEDA SAMMELAN ORGANIZED AT SRINAGAR, JAMMU & KASHMIR.



Vedas form the rock-bed of Dharma – Vedic mantras when chanted produce divine vibrations that bring peace and prosperity. A three day All India Vedic Sammelan on the full of snow beautiful peaks of mountain in sacred place and cultural heritage of Solophock – Namchi, South Sikkim had been organized on 20th March, 2015. The inaugural ceremony was organized in presence of Hon'ble Governor Shriniwas Dadasaheb Patil, learned vedic scholars, participants and distinguished invited guests along with vedic scholars visited from different states in the country.

In the jointly organized sammelan by Maharishi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan, Ujjain and Shri Siddheshwar Dham located at Namchi, a distinguished guest of inaugural ceremony, Prof. Roop Kishor Shastri, Secretary addressed about the various activities undertaken by the pratishthan throughout the country and achievements made at length. While discussing the publication of Vedic Vangamaya, Shri Shastri ji stated publication of shankhayan shakha, a rare shakha of Rigaveda by regenerating has protected the valuable inheritage of the country. He also stated that in inaccessible north-eastern states of the country, after January 2011 the pratishthan provided financial assistance and encouraged for opening a number of Veda vidyalayas speedily and in this sequence if Siddheshwar Dham at Namchi initiates proposal for opening a Veda vidyalaya, the pratishthan is committed to provide all possible assistance. On hearing this instant announcement, Hon'ble Governor along with others present there welcomed it by clapping of hands happily.

Hon'ble Governor, Shriniwas Dadasaheb Patil, chief guest of the function stated that vedas are valuable heritage of the world and insisted that all outstanding efforts should be made to keep alive the oral tradition of vedas continuously. While appreciating the various tasks of Maharishi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan, chief guest asked that both of publications "Vedavidya" a research journal and "Vedavarta" monthly newsletter of the pratishthan are significant and through it awareness of Vedic knowledgescience and traditions may be created amongst the general public.

Acharya Mohan Timsina, convener and coordinator of chardham informed that in different sessions on the first day Prof. Namonarayana Bandyopadhyaya, Prof. Virendra Kumar Vedalankar and Prof. Vikram ji stated that it is essential to undertake serious studylearning and research activities for fulfillment of various requirements of human society. In the evening, after performing Maha Arati (Great Worship Ceremony) of Lord Shri Siddheshwar, cultural programmes e.g. singing of Sanskrit stotras and public dance by girls presented, which were ear pleasant and eye beautiful.

On the eve of Nutan Samvatsar, Gudi Padva and Chaitra Navaratra, on 21st March, 2015, Saturday, the second day of sammelan all representatives and learned Vedic scholars greeted each other with enthusiasm honestly. Swami Advaitanand ji from Bangalore in his speech ascertained the significance of Indian wisdom with reference to upanishads. Later on, a renowned stars scientist and ancient knowledge learned scholar Dr. Omprakash Pandeya, Delhi in morning and afternoon sessions presented PPTs on Creation of Universe and Scientific Analysis of Nature Process, which were seen and heard by the mass gathered there and they got pleased and overpowered. Dr. Baldevanand Sagar, Sanskrit Samachar Announcer from All India Radio and Doordarshan complemented Shri Siddheshwar Dham, Namchi stating that this sacred land as favourable place for performing vedic sadhana and briefed entire activities of sammelan in his style in simple Sanskrit recited which made the listeners pleased greatly.

The valedictory ceremony of the sammelan concluded on third day of the sammelan, in which Shri Pawan Chamaling, a simple, prestigious and long sighted Chief Minister, Sikkim arrived as per schedule and he heard the speeches delivered by Sanskrit learned scholars with patience and concentration. Dr. Dharmendra Shastri, Secretary, Delhi Sanskrit Academy proposed for establishing a Sanskrit Vishwavidyalaya, Sanskrit Academy and Vedic Research Centre in Sikkim. Also Dr. Vijayakaran, Sanskrit scholar humbly requested chief minister to establish Sanskrit in the form of spoken language (bhashit bhasha). Dr. Omprakash Pandeya provided creative suggestions for primary education system of Sikkim and Dr. Baldevanand Sagar proposed for establishing a Veda vidyalaya at Namchi or any favourable place in Sikkim. At the end, Prof. Namonarayana Bandyopadhyaya along with other proposals stated that there is also a need for Pandulipi-Shodha-Kendra.

Hon'ble Chief Minister, Shripawan Chamaling in his own simple style described Siddheshwar Dham at length, located at Namchi, South Sikkim and talked about implementation of Four Sacred Dham and Dwadash Jyotirlinga. In conjunction with, all proposals of past-orators Sanskrit scholars accepted in principle and Hon'ble Chief Minister announced for establishing a veda vidyalaya which was greatly complemented by present people by clapping of hands. The Vedic scholars blessed Hon'ble Chief Minister with Vedic recitations for vedic and spiritual development and continuous growth of Sikkim offered prosperity desire. Hon'ble Chief Minister having pleased with the tasks of Maharishi Sandipani Rashtriya Vedavidya Pratishthan, Ujjain and presence of learned scholars reinvited all and distinguished scholars were honored with a token gift of carpet of Sikkim.

9.7 FELLOWSHIPS

- 9.7.1 There is a provision of Fellowship for promoting Vedic research. The Pratishsthan offers Fellowship Scheme for this purpose. The main objective of this scheme is to provide an opportunity to scholars, particularly young research scholars for promoting the growth of Vedas and different aspects of vedic literature, so as to enable them to choose research topics on research projects to undertake research work for full time basis. Under this scheme, following Fellowships have been provided :
 - 1. National Fellowship
 - 2. Senior Fellowship
 - 3. General Fellowship
 - 4. Junior Research Fellowship
- 9.7.2 Under the scheme, terms and conditions of fellowships, eligibility/ qualification, and availability of fellowships in different categories at particular period have been prescribed. Keeping in view, workability of project and availability of budget support during the particular financial year, fellowships have been provided.

9.8 PUBLICATION

9.8.1 Publication is an important programme of the Pratishthan to fulfil its objectives. The out-ofprint and rare texts relating to Vedic literature are reprinted and published under this programme. Printing of critical editions and translation into various languages of certain texts, monographs on important topics and report of research work done by Fellows of the Pratishthan are also undertaken. In addition, the research papers presented at the seminars, workshops and proceedings thereof are also taken up for publication.



9.9 PUBLICATION OF RESEARCH JOURNAL

9.9.1 In order to promote new research activities, Pratishthan publishes an International Research Journal "Ved Vidya" in which good essays related with Veda published in Hindi, English

and Sanskrit languages so that its advantage may be availed by the Vedic scholars as well as by general public. This research journal contained ISSN No. 2230-8962 is Referred Research Journal.

9.9.2 The details of Books published / financially assisted so far by the Pratishthan have been furnished at Annexure VI.



9.10 PUBLICATION OF "VEDA VARTA" - A MONTHLY NEWS LETTER.

9.10.1 Publication of "Veda Varta", a monthly news-letter introduced since May, 2012 has been continued by the Pratishthan. This newsletter covers and provides the various germane information on all programmes on vedic sammelan, seminar, examinations for pathashala / guru shishya parampara yojana, veda gyan saptah, vedic classes for all, cultural programmes in the affiliated pathashalas/units of guru shishya parampara by the Pratishthan and other special tasks being carried by the Pratishthan throughout the year. It is being circulated widely at free of cost to the all concerned and read with interest by them.



9.11 LIBRARY

9.10.1 The Pratishthan has its own well maintained Library at Ujjain, and at present it has got about 4000 books on its shelves on Vedic literature and allied subjects. The expected growth of the Library could not be done, due to eligible qualified staff is yet to be recruited. However, the number of books in library have been increased during the year. The Library system is being computerized fully which is expected to be completed soon. As a part of the overall construction programme of the Pratishthan on the land allotted to it by the State Government and as a long term measures, a growth plan for development of library with necessary building plan has been proposed.

9.12 VEDIC MATHEMATICS

9.12.1 The Pratishthan has been following research in Vedic Mathematics since inception. An Expert Committee constituted in 1992-93 has been functioning continuously. As an interim action and result of various recommendations, National Academy Research Training Council included some formulae and its applications as ready well adorned material in teachers guide and lectures on Vedic mathematics in Teachers Training Programme. In order to impart training to school teachers in Vedic Mathematics, workshops have been organized from time to time. During the year under review, no workshop could be organized.

9.13 PREPARATION OF VEDIC DIRECTORY

9.13.1 The work for ambitious scheme to maintain Vedic Directory has been completed. In order to preserve and conserve the oral tradition of vedic recitation, a Directory for Vedic scholars of different branches has been furnished. In fact, this Vedic Directory has been demanded by vedic scholars since a long. The same is under publication & would be brought out to the public soon.



9.14 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO AGED VEDAPATHIS

9.14.1 During the year 2014-15, a grant of Rs. 5,50,000/- to the Vedapath Nidhi Trust, Chennai as Pratishthan's contribution under the scheme of assisting aged Vedic Pandits has been provided. The Veda Path Nidhi Trust provides grant to the aged Veda Pathis as per following criteria and rates :

A Veda Pathi aged beyond 65 years, having a proficiency in Sanskrit and Shastra is paid Rs. 2000/- per month.

9.14.2 The Aged & Handicapped Veda Pathis aged beyond 65 years are paid grant by the Pratishthan. During the year under review, a grant of Rs. 3,96,000/- was paid by the Pratishthan to 15 Aged & Handicapped Veda Pathis @ Rs. 2000/- per month each.

9.15 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO NITYAGNIHOTRIS

9.15.1 The Pratishthan has formulated a scheme to provide financial assistance of Rs. 2000/- per month each for those Nityagnihotris, who along with their wives perform and follow traditional Vedic recitations with Agnyadhan as per

procedure and cow worship at their homes Agnihotra Anushthan regularly. The objective of providing financial assistance is to reimburse partially the expenses being incurred on performing Agnihotra Anushthan by the Agnihotris regularly. Preference has been given to those pandits/vedapathis, who are aged and perform/follow Agnihotra regularly.

9.15.2 During the year 2014-15, a grant of Rs. 9,00,000/- was paid to 58 Nityagnihotris @ Rs. 2000/- per month each by the Pratishthan.

9.16 HONOURS PAID TO VEDA PATHIS

9.16.1 On the occasion of a number of Vedic Sammelans organized at Varanasi (U.P.), Mahasamund (Chattisgarh), Pune (Maharashtra), Mysore (Karnataka), Unna (Himachal Pradesh), Namachi (South Sikkim), Bangalgaon (Assam), Guwahati (Assam), Vedapathis were honoured and paid Rs. 2100/-, 3,100/- and 5100/- as Sambhavana Rashi by the Pratishthan during the year 2014-15.

9.17 CELEBRATION OF VEDIC KNOWLEDGE WEEK

- 9.17.1 In order to create Vedic knowledge and consciousness of its implied human value, to organize a Vedic Knowledge Week in various places of the country was started by the Pratishthan. The objective of this programme is to create awakening on Veda, Vedic Knowledge and Indian Culture amongst the people in the country.
- 9.17.2 Under this scheme, in accordance with accepted rules of renowned Vedic institutions or learned scholars to conduct the various activities during the week e.g. deliver lectures on selected topics on common public interest by learned scholars, to organize exhibitions by photos, charts and models, broadcast Vedic literature messages through All India Radio and Television network, hold competition of Mantrochharan on Vedic suktas/ mantras and distribution of awards and to pay honours to learned scholars grant has been paid.
- 9.17.3 During the year under report, the Vedic Knowledge Week was organized at the following place : Gajendra Chatushpathi Kolkatta From 15 August 2014 to 21 August 2015.

9.18 TAPE RECORDING OF VEDIC RECITATIONS

9.18.1 One of the essential activity of the Pratishthan is to maintain the record for preservation oral tradition of various branches of vedas's recitation through Tape Recording C.D./D.V.D. There is a centre of tape recording of some Vedas branches at Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeeth, Tirupati. During the years 1992-93 and 1993-94, an arrangement was made by the Pratishthan with assistance of Vidyapeeth, so that a complete duplicate set of Vedas recitation could be made available. Out of the tapes available at Tirupati Vidyapeeth, its duplicate tapes have been made. The Pratishthan has collected Mantrochharan related audio-video tapes in different branches and styles from various sources. In this respect, an audio C.D. of 70 hours in M.P.-3 form collected, which are available at the Pratishthan for learned scholars. The details of C.D./D.V.D. are given at Annexure 7. Now newly constructed premises of the Pratishthan is ready and it is proposed to prepare a studio for recording purpose which would be implemented soon.

9.19 PREPARATION OF AUDIO CASSETTES PACKAGE

9.19.0 With a view to popularize Veda Vidya, in the year 1994-95 a programme has been introduced for preparation of a Package Audio Cassette of duration 20 to 25 hours initially in Hindi. The aim is to introduce Vedas, impart preliminary knowledge on Vedic Tradition and information on its implied moral and human values. It is proposed to adopt sophisticated and modern technology which is expected for early implementation.

9.20 VEDAS EDUCATION AT HOME

9.20.1 The Pratishthan has introduced a correspondence course on "Ghar Baithe Vedon Ki Shiksha". The pass Vedanuragis have been awarded "Veda Nipun" certificate. Under this scheme, syllabus has been formulated so as to reach by general public a germane information on four Vedas, Vedang, Brahmin Granth, Aranyak, Upanishad, Importance and form of Indian Culture, Indian Philosophy.



Besides, to make the syllabus interesting, vedic stories have been given at appropriate places. During the session, syllabus was carried out systematically. The above course may be opted for in Hindi or English medium.

9.21 MAHARISHI SANDIPANI RASHTRIYA VEDAVIDYA PURASKAR

It has been decided by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, New Delhi to confer a "**Sandipani Rashtriya Puraskar**" by the Pratishthan. With the approval of the Chairman & Hon'ble Union Minister, Human Resource Development Govt. of India, an Award to promote the original writings in Vedic Studies and Vedanga literature, edition of manual scripts, research in Vedic education, Vedic culture and to preserve rare vedic knowledge has been introduced by the Pratishthan since silver Jubilee Year 2012



9.22 ORGANIZED VEDIC REFRESHER COURSES FOR ENHANCEMENT OF VEDIC KNOWLEDGE

Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan, Ujjain introduced a Refresher Course for Vedic Teachers of all registered aided Veda Pathashalas by the Pratishthan, for technical advancement of vedic education, enhance the quality of their qualification & skills development. Vedic Teachers participating in this course have been availing the benefit greatly.

During the Year 2014-15, Second and Fourth refresher courses had been organized in Purva Tirupati Shri Balaji Seva Samiti Guwahati (Assam) from May, 10th to 24th, 2014 and from 20 August to 5 September, 2014 respectively by Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan, Ujjain. Third refresher course had been organized in Pratishthan campus at Ujjain from July 7th to 27th, 2014.

The Eminent persons of Veda and Sanskrit had been invited to deliver their speeches in these sessions.







OBJECTIVES

In order to fulfil the following objectives, the Pratishthan has been established :-

- 1. To preserve, conserve and develop the oral tradition of Vedic studies, for which the Pratishthan will undertake various activities such as, to provide assistance to traditional Vedic institutions and scholars, provide fellowships/scholarship, undertake preparation of audio/video tapes, etc.
- 2. To foster the tradition of intonation and recitation through learned scholars and Pandits.
- 3. To encourage and ensure involvement of dedicated students in higher research in the field.
- 4. To provide research facilities to those students having background of Vedic knowledge and to equip them with sufficient scientific and analytical outlook, so that modern scientific thoughts contained in the Vedas, particularly disciplines of mathematics, astronomy, meteorology, chemistry, hydraulics, etc. should be linked with modern science and technology so that a rapport between them and modern scholars could be established.
- 5. To establish Vedic Pathashala and research centres its takeover, manage or supervise throughout the country to fulfil and maintain any objectives of the Pratishthan.
- 6. To revive and administer such of the endowments and trusts as are de-functional, or don't run properly.
- 7. To pay special attention to those Shakhas which are extinct and for which human repositories can be identified, and to prepare a detailed list of Pandits related to these Shakhas.
- 8. To ascertain the present status of affairs of oral traditions in respect of Vedas, particularly intonation and recitation peculiar to various regions, institutions and maths in the country.
- 9. To collect information that whether original state of textual material, printed manuscripts, texts, commentaries and interpretations, etc. of the various oral traditions of Vedic Shakhas are available or unavailable.
- 10. To collect information about the present state of recordings, both audio and visual, available in the country.
- 11. To undertake research, in the interest of advancement of scientific knowledge, in Vedic texts and Vedic Literature from the earliest time of Vedic period up to the present day including areas of science, agriculture, technology, philosophy, yoga, education, poetics, grammar, linguistics and Vedic tradition and to provide for library, research equipment, research facilities, supporting staff and other technical man power; and To undertake research, in the interest of advancement of scientific knowledge, in Vedic texts and Vedic Literature from the earliest time of Vedic period up to the present day including areas of science, agriculture, technology, philosophy, yoga, education, poetics, grammar, linguistics and Vedic tradition and to provide for library, research equipment, research facilities, supporting staff and other technical man power.
- 12. To undertake all such activities as may be necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any one of the objectives of the Pratishthan, in accordance with the Memorandum of Association.
