**Annual Report  
2010-2011**

**1. Introduction**

1.1 The Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan was established in January 1987 by the Department of Education, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi. It is an autonomous organisation registered under the Societies' Registration Act, 1860. The objectives of the Pratishthan are as follows :

- (a) Preservation, conservation and development of the oral tradition of Vedic studies;
- (b) Study of the Vedas through Pathashalas as well as other means and institutions;
- (c) Creation and promotion of research facilities so as to bring out the rich wealth of knowledge contained in the Vedas and to relate it with the contemporary needs; and
- (d) Collection of information and to arrange basic facilities to store relevant material and to disseminate and publish it in various form using different resources.

1.2 A statement of the objectives as given in the Memorandum of Association is appended as Annex - I.

1.3 In May 1993, the office of the Pratishthan was shifted to Ujjain, and it was renamed as "Maharshi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan".

## **2. Authorities of Pratishtan**

**2.1** General Body and Governing Council are the Authorities of the Pratishtan. In accordance with its Memorandum of Association and Rules and Regulations, the various powers and functions for carrying out the affairs of the Pratishtan are vested in its General Body and Governing Council. Hon'ble Union Minister for Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi is the Chairman for General Body and Governing Council both. The General Body is vested with the general power for reviewing the broad policies and programmes of the Pratishtan. It also suggests measures for its improvement and development. The Governing Council is the principal executive body of the Pratishtan and responsible for the general superintendence, direction and control of its affairs.

**2.2** There is a provision in the rules of the Pratishtan for "Finance Committee". The Finance Committee is headed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chairman. The Committee is responsible for all matters pertaining to the management of the properties and investments, preparation of estimates for annual budget and statements of accounts and expenditure of the Pratishtan.

**2.3** Under its general powers, the Pratishtan has constituted a Project Committee, which comprises members of eminent scholars of Veda and related subjects for consideration of its academic projects and programmes. The composition of the present Project Committee is given in Annex II.

**2.4** The General Body, Governing Council and the Finance Committee were reconstituted by the Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi for a term of five years on Oct 5, 2004. The compositions of these bodies are given in Annex III, as it was notified by the Government of India on Oct 5, 2004. These bodies continued to function during the year under report.

### **3. Officers of the Pratishthan**

**3.1** There is a provision for a Chairman as the head of the Pratishthan in the rules of the Pratishthan. The Chairman is to be nominated by the Government of India for a term of 5 years. He presides over the meetings of the General Body and Governing Council. Hon'ble Minister for Human Resource Development is the Chairman of the Pratishthan at present.

**3.2** The rules of the Pratishthan also provide a clause for a Vice-Chairman to be nominated by the Chairman. The Vice-Chairman has to perform such duties and exercise such functions and powers as the Chairman may specify generally or in any individual case. Professor S. Sudarshan Sharma (Vice-Chancellor, Shri Venkateshwari Vedic University, Tirupati) holds the post of Vice-Chairman since 24-5-2010.

**3.3** There is a provision in rules and regulations of the Pratishthan that there should be a full-time and salaried person who will act as a secretary and he/she shall be the head for academic as well as administrative activities. The Secretary exercises general supervision and control over the affairs of the Pratishthan and implements the decisions taken by the authorities of the Pratishthan.

**3.4** Professor Roop Kishor Shastri (Head, Department of Veda, Gurukul Kangri Vishwavidyalaya, Haridwar) is appointed as a full-time Secretary of the Pratishthan by Government of India vide order no 6-16/2010-SKT/ | dated 6-12-2010. Professor Shastri has taken over the charge as a Secretary of the Pratishthan since 5-1-2011.

#### **4. Other Officers and Staff**

4.1 In pursuance of the recommendations of its Internal Work Study Unit, the Department of Education had on 14.8.98 accorded sanction of the Government to the creation of one post each of Director, Programme Officer, Section Officer and Accountant and two posts each of Assistant and Peon, as part of interim organisational set-up for the Pratishthan. The Governing Council of the Pratishthan in its meeting held on 21.2.2000 approved byelaws for recruitment for all the sanctioned posts of the Pratishthan. Ministry permitted for the appointment of these posts vide no 6-10/2010-SKT/ | dated 13-1-2011. The process for the appointments is in progress.

4.2 The Governing Council of the Pratishthan and Standing Finance Committee of the Government (24.11.98) approved under-mentioned posts for the new long-term organisational set-up of the Pratishthan in the first phase for operation, depending upon the amount of work and activities generated in the Pratishthan. These posts also included those already filled up and in operation :

**4.3** The work of the Pratishthan related to academic as well as administrative and financial matters continued to be carried out under the supervision of Member-Secretary. The appointments were made on ad-hoc basis for some officers and its support staff. It consist of Officer on Special Duty (F) -1, Internal Account Officer -1, C group staff - 3.

## **5. *Headquarters***

**5.1** The headquarters office of the Pratishthan is in its own building at second floor in 'B' Wing of the Pradhikaran Bhawan at Ujjain (M.P.) which had been purchased by the Pratishthan from the Ujjain Development Authority in February, 1993. As a long-term measure, the State Government of Madhya Pradesh had allotted land measuring 9.55.3 Hectares (23.6 acres) to the Pratishthan. The State Government handed over the possession of the land to the Pratishthan in April., 1994.

**5.2** In accordance with the decision taken by the Governing Council of the Pratishthan, the work of preparation of the design of Pratishthan's buildings, etc. was entrusted to the Chief Architect of the C.P.W.D. The Pratishthan obtained plans and estimates prepared by the C.P.W.D. for construction of buildings and development of land at Ujjain in November and December, 1999 in two lots. Thereafter expeditious action was taken to obtain the Government's approval for provision of necessary funds for the said purpose. A Memorandum on the subject was referred to the Ministry of HRD for seeking approval of the Standing Finance Committee of the Government in this regard. The SFC in its meeting

held on 4.8.2000 considered the Memorandum. The SFC had decided that the proposals may be reformulated in the light of the discussions held in the meeting and the matter may again be brought before the Committee soon. Meanwhile, the Committee had approved the proposal for construction of Boundary wall and Gate at an estimated cost of Rs.62.58 lakhs. The Ministry had also sanctioned a grant of Rs.62.58 lakhs to the Pratishthan for this purpose.

**5.3** The meeting of Standing Finance Committee (S.F.C.) was held on 18-12-2007 for the construction of building and development of campus. For this an amount of Rs 25.02 Crore was sanctioned. For this purpose, C.P.W.D. handed over maps for the construction of building to the Pratishthan. It was permitted by the Pratishthan on March 2008. The amount of Rs 2 crore and 80 lacs received as a grant in aid from the ministry during the year 2010-11 and submitted to Central Public Work Department, Indore. The tender for other buildings is in dilemma due to the involvement of Central Public Work Department (CPWD). The construction work is dead due to unefficiency of the CPWD.

## **6. *Corpus Fund of the Pratishthan***

**6.1** At the time of establishment of the Pratishthan, Government had envisaged that a Corpus Fund of Rupees Ten Crores would be placed at its disposal so that recurring income from its investment may be utilised for financing various activities and programmes of the Pratishthan. By the end of 1996-97 total amounts of Rupees Ten Crores was provided by Government in installments for this purpose.

**6.2** As per decision taken on 18-10-2001 in the meeting of the Finance Committee, a sum of Rs.10, 51, 44, 931.74 lying in the general fund has been added in the Corpus Fund. Now the Corpus Fund has been a sum of Rs.20, 51, 44,931.74.

## 7. *New Programmes Approved*

7.1 The Standing Finance Committee (SFC) of the Government of India in its meeting held on 24.11.98 had considered the proposal of the Pratishthan for enhancement of its Corpus Fund. After detailed discussion, the Committee was satisfied about the need and justification for enhanced requirement of funds by the Pratishthan for sustaining the on-going programmes and for introducing new academic programmes, which are required to fulfill the objectives of the Pratishthan.

7.2 The Standing Finance Committee (SFC) decided to provide the additional requirement of funds by annual budgetary support from Government instead of through enhancement of Corpus Fund. It was also emphasized by the SFC that the Pratishthan's activities and Programmes would not be allowed to suffer due to paucity of funds and the budgetary allocations would be protected. In accordance with the decision of SFC, the Department of Education of the Ministry of HRD released 12 Crore during 2010-11 as grant-in-aid to the Pratishthan towards additional expenditure on on-going programmes.

7.3 The new academic programmes, which were accepted by the SFC, have been given below. The position obtaining during the year under report about their implementation has been indicated in brackets below each, where applicable:

- (1) Financial assistance to Special Gurukulas for sustenance of Shakhas of Vedas, which are on the verge of extinction.
  - (a) Thrissur in Kerala for Samaveda, Jaimniya Shakha
  - (b) Baripada, Mayurbhanj [Orissa] for Atharva Veda {Paipplada Shakha}
  - (c) Guiyahpal, Singhbhum {Jharkhand} for Atharva Veda {Paipplada Shakha}Gurukulas have been identified for financial assistance. At present, these are being provided financial assistance under the scheme of "Preservation of oral tradition of vedic

recitation", Action is in progress to identify more Special Gurukulas. Atharvaveda, Paippalad Shakha at Chitrakut (Madhya Pradesh) and in Jharkhand & Orissa States has been started.

- (2) Preservation of Sravita Karma Parampara and its documentation.

(For the present, action is in progress to collect video cassettes/CD ROMs of Soma Yajnas and other Yajnas/Ishtis performed/ to be performed elsewhere by Non-Government Organizations, etc. The Pratishthan's own performance of Yajanas and their documentation will be taken up after requisite officers and staff is in position).

- (3) Implementation of publication programmes for bringing out rare and out-of-print Veda Samhitas, Brahmanas and other Vedic literature.

(The publication of quarterly Research journal "Vedavidya" has been started. Effective steps have also been taken for prestigious project viz. compilation of "Vedic Directory".

- (4) The correspondence course "Ghar Baithe Vedon ki Shiksha" has been continued by the Pratishthan. The aim of the course is to disseminate vedic knowledge among common people. The Vedic knowledge includes 4 Vedas, 6 Vedangas, Brahmin Grantha, Aranyaka, Upanishad and the role and importance of Indian Culture and Philosophy.

**7.4 Formulation of comprehensive project reports and/or plan of action for implementation of new programmes continued during the year under report.**

**N. Meetings of Authorities of Pratishthan and Important Decisions**

**8.1** During the year under report, meetings of various Authorities/Bodies of the Pratishthan were held as per details given below:-

**8.2** The important decisions taken by the said Bodies/Authorities are as follow :-

- (1) The Project Committee has sanctioned national and regional Vedic conferences scheduled to organise during the year.
- (2) The Project Committee has sanctioned seminars and workshops scheduled to organise during the year 2010-11.

**Finance Committee:**

- (1) Finance Committee has approved the annual budget for the year 2010-11.
- (2) The Committee sanctioned the articles approved by the Auditor-General for the year 2009-10.

**Governing Council**

- (1) The Governing Council has sanctioned the articles approved by the Auditor-General for the year 2009-10.

**Grant-in-Aid Committee**

- (1) The Committee has sanctioned the amount for financial assistance for the year 2010-11 under the scheme of Guru-Shishya tradition and several Ved Pathshalas run by the Pratishtan.

**General Sabha**

- (1) Second Vishwa Veda Sammelan for the year 2012 was sanctioned during the silver jubilee celebration by the pratishtan..
- (2) International Vedic conference is sanctioned for the year 2012.
- (3) It was sanctioned to prepare a list for senior vedic scholars for conducting examination in the schools by the Pratishtan

**9. On-going Programmes and Activities**

9.0 The Pratishtan has been pursuing a number of programmes and activities for the achievement of its objectives enshrined in its Memorandum of Association since its inception. During the year under report, the following programmes and activities were continued by the Pratishtan:

#### **9.1 Financial Assistance to Vedic Institutions**

**9.1.1** One of the objectives of the Pratishthan is to establish, take over, manage or supervise Vedic Pathashalas/Research Centres in all over the country and maintain or run them for any of the objectives of the Pratishthan. Under this provision, financial assistance is given to various Veda Pathashalas/Vidyalayas in the country.

**9.1.2** The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, New Delhi had transferred the scheme of financial assistance to Voluntary Organizations (Veda Pathashalas) for promotion of Vedic education to the Pratishthan for execution w.e.f. 1.4.1994, along with the budgetary allocation. Under this scheme, grant-in-aid is paid to Organisations/Institutions/Pathashalas towards honorarium of Veda teachers and stipend of Veda students. The rates of honorarium of Veda teachers and stipend of students have been increased since 1.10.2007. According to the revised rates, a whole-time Veda teacher is paid honorarium @ Rs.5500/- per month. An honorarium @ Rs. 7500/- per month is paid to those Veda teachers who are engaged in teaching of Vedas for more than 5 years and @ Rs. 8500/- per month is paid to those Veda teachers who are engaged in teaching of Vedas for more than 10 years.

**9.1.3** A full-time Veda student is paid stipend @ Rs.1000/-p.m. of which Rs.500/-p.m. would be deposited by the Pathashala in Fixed/Recurring deposit in a Nationalised Bank in the name of the student as deferred Stipend Account of the student in accordance with the instructions laid down by the Pratishthan for the purpose. The accumulated amount in the Bank together with interest is released to the concerned student in one lump sum on successful completion of his studies. The remaining Rs.500/- would be utilized by the Pathashala on the maintenance of the student. The managements of the Pathashalas are required to feed the students properly up to prescribed nutrition standard for

students and provide necessary funds for the purpose from their own resources also. The management of the Pathashala is required to keep proper accounts of actual expenditure under the sub-head "Maintenance of students" both in respect of grant-in-aid provided by the Pratishthan as well as the funds provided by them from their own resources.

**9.1.4** During the year 2010-11 under report, the Ministry of HRD, GOI, New Delhi provided Rs 12, 00, 00,000/- as a grant-in-aid to the Pratishthan for the year 2010-11 for additional expenditure on the construction of new campus, on-going projects on account of enhancement of honorarium of Veda teachers and stipend of Veda students of Veda Pathashalas and enhancement of honorarium of Swadhyayi-teachers and scholarship of students participating in the scheme of "Preservation of oral tradition of Vedic recitation".

**9.1.5** The Pratishthan invite applications along with all relevant details in respect of Vedic Pathashalas/ Vidyalayas, their teachers and students. The information furnished by Pathashalas was examined. After satisfying about various conditions and requirements, etc. grant was released to various Pathashalas.

**9.1.6** During the financial year 2010-11 Rs. 229.95 lakhs were paid as honorarium to 342 Veda teachers of 51 Ved Pathshalas/Schools of all over the country, Rs. 270.10 lakhs were paid as a stipend to 2302 students. The casual expenditure was Rs 62.72 lakhs and a total amount of Rs. 562.77 lakhs was released to Pathashalas/ Vidyalayas during the year under report.

**9.1.7** During the financial year 2010-11 Rs. 247467 were paid as honorarium to 4 teachers of 2 Ved Pathshalas/Schools of North-East states, Rs. 348000 were paid as a stipend to 33 students. The contingent expenditure was Rs 82800 and a total amount of Rs. 678267 was released to Pathashalas/ Vidyalayas during the year under report. For

Kolkata between 14-12-2010 to 15-12-2010. The examinations of Vedic students of Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and Jharkhand States were organized at Shri Narottamanand Ved Vidyalaya, Jhusi Allahabad on 20.12.2010 to 22.12.2010. The examinations of Vedic students of southern states were organized at Raja Ved Pathshala, Kumbhakonam, Tamilnadu on 27.12.2010 to 29.12.2010. The examinations of Vedic students of Maharashtra and Gujarat states were organized at Sant Gyaneshwar Ved Vidya Pratishtan, Aurangabad on 5-1-2011 to 6-1-2011. The examinations of the students for remaining states were organized at Ujjain on 5.3.2011 and 6.3.2011 respectively. Expenditure on organisation of above examination on account of T.A. of students and Honorarium to examinars amounting to Rs. 24.28 lakhs were spent during 2010-11.

**9.2.3** The sixth convocation programme was organized on March 8, 2011 in the Surya Narayan Sankul Sabhagar, Kalidas Academy, Ujjain. Hon'ble Governor of Madhya Pradesh Shri Rameshwar Thakur was the chief guest The Certificates of "Veda Vibhushan" were given to 413 Samhitapathi Vedic students (passed during this year) by Professor Satyavrat Shastri (Delhi). Professor Sudarshan Sharma (Vice Chancellor Shri Venkateshwar Vishwavidyalaya, Tirupati and Vice President of the Pratishthan and Professor Roop Kishor Shastri Secretary of the Pratishthan given blessing to students and expressed the contribution of the pratishthan. Professor T.R. Thapak (Vice Chancellor, Vikram University, Ujjain) Dr Mohan Gupt(Vice Chancellor Maharishi Panini Sanskrit University, Ujjain) and various scholars were present on this occasion. The Vedic teachers were awarded during the splendid programme in presence of Vedic scholars and local citizens. Dr Phalguni Desai, Surat (Gujarat) conducted the programme.

### **9.3 Scheme for Preservation of Oral Tradition of Vedic Recitation**

**9.3.1** This scheme had been in operation in government during 5th five-year plan and it was transferred to the Pratisthan for execution with effect from 1.4.1994. It is meant for providing special incentive for the preservation of the oral tradition of Vedic recitation. A Swadhyayi-teacher is required to teach at least five to maximum of ten students at his home or any suitable place in their locality under the scheme. The selected Swadhyayi-teacher for the said purpose is expected to possess mastery of at least one Shakha of one of the Vedas. He is required to give special coaching to the students in recitation specially assigned to him for this purpose, so that they become proficient in reciting the complete Samhita with Swara of the particular Shakha for which he is qualified. The duration of coaching for each student is six years.

**9.3.2** The parents of the students are required to execute an indemnity bond for the value of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties to the effect that they will not withdraw their wards from the course of study for a minimum period of six years, and if they happen to do so, they will be liable to refund the entire amount paid as scholarship up-to-date, or Rs.10,000/-, whichever is more. The scholar-teacher is also required to give an undertaking to abide with the terms and conditions of the scheme. The rates for honorarium payable to Swadhyayi-teacher and scholarship to Veda student is Rs. 5000/- p.m. and Rs 500/-p.m. respectively.

**9.3.3** The grant was provided to 207 Units under the Vedic Saswar Yojana during the year under report. 207 Swadhyayi-teachers and 1780 Vedic students participated in the scheme and financial assistance of Rs.206.74 lakhs was provided to them.

**9.3.4** The grant was provided to 4 Units under the Vedic Saswar Yojana during the year under report to North-East states. 4 Swadhyayi-teachers and 48 Vedic students participated in the scheme and financial assistance of Rs.4.25 lakhs was provided to them.

#### **9.4 *Vedic Classes for all***

**9.4.1** The Pratishtan has a scheme of conducting Vedic Classes to disseminate Vedic knowledge and popularising Vedic studies for all those who are interested in the concerned subject, even they do not possess the required academic qualification. Over all, 100 lectures in all specific topics of Veda are being delivered under this scheme. There is provision for two lectures on each Saturday and Sunday. The course structure, including the topics of lectures, has been prescribed by the Pratishtan. The financial assistance provided for these classes are as follows:

**9.4.2** During the year under report, Vedic Classes conducted by Naisargik Shodh Samsthan, Varanasi.

#### **9.5 *Seminars***

**9.5.0** The seminars are being organized for promotion of research in the thrust areas of the Pratishtan. These are fully or partially financed by the Pratishtan. The Pratishtan continued this activity and provided financial assistance for organizing the following seminars by different organizations during the year under report.

#### **9.5.1 All India Vedic Seminar on the subject Veda Evam Sanskrit Upanishad and Ved Mantra Path Pratiyogita at Ajmer (Rajasthan).**

A two day All India Vedic seminar was organised on February 19-20, 2011 with the help of Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati Vishwavidyalaya, Ajmer (Rajasthan) in Ajmer.

His Excellency Dr Kamla Ji, Governor of Gujarat inaugurated the inaugural session of the seminar held on February 19, 2011. Mahamahim stated in his meaningful address that Veda are the oldest inheritance in the world. There is no such problem or tendency in the world that discussion and solution are not available in the Veda. Professor Bhagirath Singh (Vice-Chancellor, Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati Vishwavidyalaya, Ajmer) presided over this session. Professor Bhudev Sharma, America was the main speaker. Professor Swatantra Kumar (Vice-Chancellor, Gurukul Kangri University, Haridwar) and Dr Shri Gopal Baheti (Former M.L.A.) were present as the special speaker. Professor Roop Kishor Shastri (Secretary, Maharishi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pratishthan Ujjain proposed welcome to all participants and presented objectives of the pratishthan. Professor Subhash vedalankar (Organisor of the seminar, secretary and incharge) delivered information on the objectives of the programme. Professor Mokshraj conducted the seminar.

Dr Anita Jain, Dr Alpana Sharma, Dr Mamta Chaturvedi, Professor Suresh Shastri (Delhi), Dr Satyawati, Dr Archana Dube (Bansthal, Rajasthan), Dr Nandita Singh, Dr Vandana Sharma, Dr. Manisha Sharma (Haryana), Dr. Ramesh Chandra Murari, Professor Virendra Kumar (Chandigarh), Professor Shrikrishna Sharma (Haryana), Professor Arun Sharma (Haryana) Professor Kedarnath (Jammu-Kashmir) Professor Rajendra Mishra (Shimla), Professor Dharamvir (Ajmer) etc. intellectuals presented their research papers on this day of second session.

On February 20, 2011, scholars come from various provinces of the country presented their papers in the morning session. After that Ved Path competition held in chief guestship of Professor Roop Kishor Shastri (Secretary, Maharishi Sandipani Rashtriya Veda Vidya Pravishthan Ujjain). Professor Girish Khosla (America) was the president. Professor Satyajit was the special guest. Professor Mahesh Nande (Pushkar) was the hon'ble guest. Professor Kedarnath (Jammu-Kashmir) was the special guest.

Shri Mahendra Lal Kumawat (Chairman, Rajasthan Public Service Commission) was the chief guest of the valedictory session of this day. Professor Rajendra Mishra was the main speaker. Professor Bhagirath Singh (Vice-Chancellor, Maharishi Dayanand Saraswati Vishwavidyalaya, Ajmer) was the chairman of the programme. Professor Subhash Taneja (Organising secretary and incharge) proposed vote of thanks to all participants. The valedictory session was coordinated by Professor Mokshraj.

In this way, a two day national Vedic seminar was over.

#### **9.5.2. All India Vedic Seminar on Upved Gandharva Veda and Sangeet Shastra in Varanasi (U.P.)**

A three day All India Vedic Seminar was jointly organized by Shri Pattabhitam ShastiVed Mimansa Research Centre and Gyan Pravah Varanasi at Varanasi between February 28, 2011 to March 2, 2011.

Professor Kamlesh Datt Tripathi (Professor-Emeritus, Kashi Hindu Vishwavidyalaya) presided over the inaugural session held on February 28, 2011. ## **9.6 *Vedic Conferences (Vedic Sammelans)***

**9.6.0** The Vedic Conferences play a significant role in the programmes of the Pratishthan and helpful to disseminate Vedic studies and knowledge in all over the country. A national conference (One All-India) and six regional Vedic conferences are held for three days, including the time for inaugural and valedictory functions. These conferences are organized in collaboration with eminent Vedic institutions, Universities, Vidyapeethas, etc. In places where such institutions are not available, Organising Committees of eminent scholars and prominent persons are constituted to conduct the Sammelans.

The Pratishthan organized five regional and one All India Vedic Conferences during the financial year 2010-2011. The detail for the conferences organized by the Pratishthan are follows:

### **9.6.1 *Regional Vedic Conference in Golaghat (Assam)***

A three day regional Vedic conference was organized with the help of Bhardwaj Shanti Ashram N- Gosai Satra, Bangalgoan, Dergoan, Golaghat(Assam) between May 27 & 29, 2010.

## **9.7 Fellowships**

**9.7.1** There is a provision for fellowships to promote Vedic research. For this purpose, a comprehensive fellowships scheme is in operation in the Pratishthan. The main objective of the scheme is to promote research on various aspects of Vedas and Vedic Literature by providing

opportunity to scholars, specially the young research scholars so that they can complete the depth study on research topic of their choice under research projects on a full-time basis.

The following fellowships are being provided under the scheme:

- (1) National Fellowships;
- (2) Senior Fellowships;
- (3) General Fellowships;
- (4) Junior Research Fellowships, and
- (5) Training Fellowships

**9.7.2** The eligibility, qualifications, terms and conditions for the Fellowships, the number of various categories of Fellowships available at a particular point of time, etc. are laid down in the scheme. The Fellowships are actually awarded keeping in view the viability of the Fellowship projects and the availability of budget provision during a particular financial year.

## **9.8 Publications**

**9.8.1** Publication is an important programme of the Pratishthan to fulfil its objectives. The Out-of-print and rare texts relating to Vedic literature are reprinted and published under this programme. Printing of critical editions and translations into various languages of certain texts, monographs on important topics and report of research work done by Fellows of Pratishthan are also undertaken. In addition, the research papers presented at the seminars, workshops and the proceedings thereof are also taken up for publication.

**9.8.2** Katvayan Mooladhyaya Parishisht and Rigvediya Shandkhayanshakhiyo Rudrapath collection were published during this financial year.

### **9.9 Publication of Journal**

9.9.1 The Pratishthan also publishes a quarterly Journal namely "Vedvidya" in which good outstanding essays related with Veda published in Hindi, English and Sanskrit so that both the scholars and common people may avail advantage of it. It is a refereed research journal with ISSN No 2230-8962.

9.9.2 The details of Books published/financially assisted so far by the Pratishthan are given in Annex VI.

### **9.10 Library**

9.10.1 The Pratishthan is maintaining a Library of its own at Ujjain, and at present the Library has about 3000 books on its shelves on Vedic literature and allied subjects. Because there is limitation of space in the building of the Pratishthan at Pradhikaran Bhawan, Ujjain and qualified library staff is yet to be recruited, specific growth of the Library has not taken place since 1993-94 but in the present year some number of books increased in the Library. As part of the overall construction programme of the Pratishthan on the land allotted to it by the State Government, and as a long-term measure, a growth plan along with necessary building plan for the Library of the Pratishthan is under process.

### **9.11 Vedic Mathematics**

9.11.1 The Pratishthan has been inspiring the research in Vedic Mathematics right from the inception. During 1992-93, an Expert Committee set up on this subject had been at work. As a result of follow-up action on various recommendations of the Expert Committee, NCERT had included some Sutras and their applications as enrichment materials in teachers' training programme. Workshops are also being conducted pe-

riodically for training of school teachers in Vedic Mathematics. During the year under report, no workshop could be organized for the said purpose.

### ***9.12 Scheme for preparation of 'Vedic Directory'***

**9.12.1** The work is in progress under its ambitious scheme to prepare 'Vedic Directory'. Video-recording of recitation of various Shakhas of Vedas, Brahmanas, etc. by utilizing Digital or CD Rom technique for preservation of oral tradition of Vedic recitation.

**9.12.2** Preservation of rare Vedic manuscripts through digital or CD Rom technique. Manus data sheets of Manuscripts available with various institutions are preparing at present.

### ***9.13 Financial Assistance to Aged Veda pathis***

**9.13.1** During the year 2010-11, a grant of Rs.5,50,000/- was paid to the Veda Patha Nidhi Trust, Chennai as Pratishthan's contribution to their scheme of assisting aged Veda Pathis. The Veda Pata Nidhi Trust provides grant to aged Veda Pathis at the following rates:

- (1) Veda Pathis who have crossed 80 years of age and are trained in Sanskrit and Shastras, financial assistance is given @ Rs.600/-p.m. each.
- (2) Veda Pathis who are above the age of 80 years, financial assistance is given @ Rs.500/-p.m. each.
- (3) Other Veda Pathis, who are aged 65 years and above, financial assistance, is given @ Rs.400/-p.m. each.

9.13.2 Pratishthan provides financial assistance direct to Aged Veda Pathis who have crossed the age of 65 years and handicapped Veda Pathis. During the year under report, a grant of Rs. 2,32,000/- was paid directly by the Pratishthan to 47 Aged Veda Pathis @ Rs.500/-p.m. each. Due to the death of an aged Vedpathi, only 8 months grant provided.

#### ***9.14 Financial Assistance to Nityagnihotries***

9.14.1 The Pratishthan has a scheme of providing financial assistance @ Rs.1000/- p.m. to such Nityagnihotries, who along with their wives, have been performing Nityagnihotra at their homes regularly, including serving of cow, according to ancient Vedic tradition for the well being of Universe. The financial assistance is meant for meeting partially the expenditure incurred by the Nityagnihotri for performing the Nityagnihotra. Preference is given to those old aged Vedists, who have no better source of income to perform this compulsory rite of Agnihotra.

9.14.2 A grant for the said purpose is under process with officers and is expected to released soon during 2010-11.

#### ***9.15 Honouring Veda Pathis***

9.15.1 During the year 2010-11, Veda Pathis were honoured by paying Rs.2500/-each as "Sambhavana" at Golaghat (Assam), Kolkata(West Bengal), Balsad(Gujarat), Aurangabad (Maharashtra), Ujjain (Madhya Pradesh), Rajapalayam(Chennai).

#### ***9.16 Celebration of Veda Gyan Saptah***

9.16.1 The Pratishthan started the programme of celebration of "Veda Gyan Saptah" in various parts of the country, in order to promote Vedic

literacy. The programme aims at creating awareness in the country about the Vedas, Vedic knowledge and Indian culture.

**9.16.2** Under this programme, grants are provided in accordance with the approved norms to renowned Vedic institutions or scholars for undertaking during full one week such activities as lectures by eminent Vedic Scholars on selected topics of utility to the general public, exhibitions through paintings, charts, models, etc., relaying suitable messages related to Vedic sayings on the A.I.R. and Doordarshan network, competition of recitation of Vedic Suktas/Mantras among the students and award of prizes, honouring Vedic Scholars, etc. The celebrations are arranged in prominent cities.

### **9.17 *Tape-Recording of Vedic Recitations***

**9.17.1** The tape-recording of the recitation of various Vedic Shakhas is an essential activity of the Pratiṣṭhan for the preservation of the oral tradition. A nucleus of tape-recording of certain shakhas existed in the Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeeth at Tirupati. During 1992-93 and 1993-94 arrangements had been made with that Vidyapeeth to get the tapes duplicated for the Pratiṣṭhan, so that a complete set of Veda recitations, which have so far been tape-recorded, is available centrally. The tapes available with the Vidyapeeth at Tirupati have been duplicated. The details of Audio-Video tapes in respect of Vedic recitations of different Shakhas and in different styles collected by the Pratiṣṭhan from various sources are given in Annex VII.

**9.17.2** A lot of more work remains to be done in this field. Due to variety of reasons, the Pratiṣṭhan has not been able to make any progress in this direction. A plan is being prepared for resuscitation of the tape-recording programme.

### **9.18 Preparation of Audio Cassette Package**

9.18.0 The programme for communicating elementary knowledge, introduction to ved containing human and moral values, vedic tradition for the purpose of publicity of vedavidya. An audio cassette package for 20 to 25 hours was made in 1994-95. Initially it was in hindi. An expert is preparing material for cassette. After evaluation it will be prepared in English and other languages.

### **9.19 Ghar Baite Vedon ki Shiksha**

9.19.1 A two years correspondence course "Ghar Baite Vedon ki Shiksha" has been introduced by the Pratishtan. A certificate "Ved Nipun" would be provided to passed Vedic scholars. The aim of the course is to disseminate Vedic knowledge among common people. The Vedic knowledge includes 4 Vedas, 6 Vedangas, Brahmin Grantha, Aranyaka, Upanishad and the role and importance of Indian Culture and Philosophy. There is a provision to deliver lecture and gathas for creating aptitude for this syllabus. The course is well to do in this session. The course may be done in hindi and english also.

**OBJECTIVES**

---

The objectives for which the Pratishthan is established are :-

- (i) To preserve, conserve and develop the oral tradition of Vedic studies for which the Pratishthan will undertake various activities such as, support traditional Vedic institutions and scholars, provide fellowships/scholarship, undertake production of audio/video tapes, etc.
  - (ii) To foster the tradition of intonation and recitation through the human agency;
  - (iii) To encourage and ensure involvement of dedicated students in higher research in the field.
  - (iv) To provide for research facilities to students with the background of Vedic Knowledge and to equip them with sufficient scientific and analytical outlook, so that modern scientific thought contained in the Vedas, particularly disciplines of mathematics, astronomy, meteorology, chemistry, hydraulics, etc. could be linked with modern science and technology and a rapport established between them and modern scholars;
  - (v) To establish, take over, manage or supervise Vedic patheshalas/research centres all over the country, maintain or run them for any of the objects of the society.
  - (vi) To revive and administer such of the endowments and trusts as are defunct, or not properly run;
  - (vii) To give special attention to Shakhas which are extinct and for which human repositories can be identified, and to prepare a detailed list of pandits related to these Shakhas;
  - (viii) To ascertain the present status of oral traditions relating to the Vedas, particularly intonation and recitation peculiar to various regions, institutions and mathas in the country;

- (ix) To collect information about the state of textual material, printed manuscripts, texts, commentaries and interpretations, etc. of the various oral traditions of Vedic Shakhas;
- (x) To collect information about the present state of recordings, both audio and visual, available in the country.
- (xi) To undertake research, in the interest of advancement of scientific knowledge, in Vedic texts and Vedic Literature from the earliest time of Vedic period upto the present day including areas of science, agriculture, technology, philosophy, yoga, education, poetics, grammar, linguistics and vedic tradition and to provide for library, research equipment, research facilities, supporting staff and other technical man power; and
- (xii) To undertake all such activities as may be necessary, incidental or conducive to the attainment of all or any of the objectives of the Pratishthan in accordance with the Memorandum of Society.
