They give new insight for research. The Upavedas like Dhanurveda (Archery) Sthapatyaveda (Architecture) Gandharvaveda (Fine Arts) and Ayurveda (Medical Science) also contain a lot of basic and important insightful information needed to gain mastery over the matter, on which further research and study is also necessary.
